State of Carolina, Cape Hatteras March the 29th 1822
County of Currituck I Amey Williams make this my
last will and Testament
I leave to my grand son Willis Jones one Bed, bedstead,
and furniture and likewise I leave to my grandson
Mills Jones one Bed and one chest and one sugar Box -
I leave to my grand daughter Sally Jones one bedstead
Bed and furniture and one Chest and one sugar Box one
water picher and one Band Box and another sugar
Box one small wheel, one loom one Boat and all therein
two Sows to be sold five ewes goats and three Barrows
hogs one large harness tub two bee hives three chairs
one small chest one linen wheel one kattle one bread
tray one washing tub, half bushel one Eye Pot one
pot, one oven one miller three axes four base bottles
four jugs two Iron Meds & one pair stit yards
one Cart three head of Sheep Henry Kinney to keep
my house this present year & then I also give my
house and land where I now live to my two grand
children Will Jones and Sally Jones to be rented
out for the benefit of them and twenty five
acres of land on the sea side to be sold for
the benefit of them

The last Will and Testament of Mr. Matthias
Exhibited and proved at Nov Term 1822.
In the name of God amen. I John Matthias of the County of
Currituck and State of North Carolina being sick and weak
but of sound mind and memory do make this my last will
and Testament viz: I give and bequeath unto my son John
Matthias a certain piece or parcel of land beginning at
the main road running down a ditch southwaidly to
the canal. It being the westwardly part of the plantation
together with all the buildings except a small house on the
Southward end of the land near the woods to him and heirs
forever. I give and bequeath unto my son William Matthias
a piece of land commencing at John's line and down the
ditch to the canal. Thence down the canal to the main
road and along the main road to the crop road opposite
Matthias store house, thence along the road to the first
station also I give him a small house on John's position
led near the woods to him and heirs forever. I provide that
the said John and William Matthias do vacate and raise
my son William Matthias clear of charges. I give and
bequeath unto my son Simon Matthias a small piece
of woodlands lying over the canal and binding on the
canal to him and heirs forever. I give and bequeath
unto my two daughters Nancy and Barbara Matthias
all the rest and residue of my property whatever to be
equally divided between them to them and their heirs
forever. I hereby make constitute and appoint my
son William Matthias my executor to this my last
Will and Testament, thereby revoking and making void
all former wills, legacies and bequests theretofore from
me made; ratifying and acknowledging this only
to be my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal the thirteenth
day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and twenty two
