In the name of God amen. I Mr. Matthias of the County of  
 Currituck and State of North Carolina being sick and weak  
 but of sound mind and memory, do make this my last will  
 and testament viz: I give and bequeath unto my son John  
 Matthias a certain piece or parcel of land beginning at  
 the main road, running down a ditch southwaidly to  
 the canal, it being the westwardly part of the plantation  
 together with all the buildings except a small house on the  
 Southward end of the land, near the woods to him and heirs  
 forever. I give and bequeath unto my son Hillary Matthias  
 a piece of land commencing at John's line and down the  
 ditch to the canal, thence down the canal to the main  
 road and along the main road to the crop road opposite  
 Matthias stone house, thence along the road to the first
