I Give to my daughter Nancy Nicholson five Shillings
and no more.

I Give to my daughter Sally Thomson all the residue of my Personal
Estate of what Nature so kind what I have to her and her heirs forever
Lastly I Nominate constitute and appoint Samuel Taylor Esquire and
Benjamin Taylor Gent. my Executors of this my last will and Testament in
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 1st day of
November 1804

On the Name of God amen. I Maurice Waucom Gent. of the State of North
Carolina and County of Currituck being weak of body and of Perfect Sound
Memory be it Remembered that on this twentieth day of July in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and four, and Publick did my last will and Testament in
Manuscript following that is to say, first I have unto my beloved wife Judith
Waucom my house and Plantation, together with the improvement of
the same and my two negroes and also for negroes to suit. Second I have
to my wife and daughter during of her natural life or widowhood
two negroes and a dozen of the best of my land upon which I have
the said negroes called Lewis. I have also unto my Son Daniel Waucom
his one half of the land also my wife and daughter is to have the other half above
mentioned negroes shall be equally divided amongst all my Sons and daughters
For this one benefit of school education I have unto my said wife Judith
the father's bed and furniture, and two horses and one mare, also some
of my slaves to suit, Jack, Dave, and Reuben, also five cows and calves during
of her natural life, or widowhood and after my death my said wife
shall be to have the above mentioned beds and horse and calves shall be
Equally divided amongst my Sons and daughters, for the one benefit of school
My wife and daughter is to have all my household furniture such as
Glass, Pew, and Iron except one third part taken out for my said wife
and daughter shall be equally divided amongst my Sons and daughters, for the
one benefit and school. My wife and daughter is to have all my women's wear
shall be equally divided amongst my Sons and daughters, except one third part to
be taken out for my wife and daughter. I Give and bequeath
unto my Son Ephraim Waucom one certain tract of land lying and being on the
North east Side of Roanoke Island, beginning at the front corner of
My new house running easterly by the shore along the bank to Solomon
Wharf and to the front corner along the line to the main road then down
to Daniel Waucom's line from thence to the first Station for his use
and benefit I Give and bequeath unto my Son Daniel Waucom
a certain tract of land joining the land of Ephraim Waucom and Maguire's land and
joining the line to the main road for his use and benefit I Give
and bequeath unto my Son of Philip Waucom the tract of land containing
three acres, after my said wife's marriage or decease, the same
beginning at the front corner of Maurice Waucom's land and
running thence east so far as to contain the width of my plantation then
to the main road then along Maurice Waucom's land line and
along the line to the first Station for his use and benefit.
I Give and bequeath unto my two Sons Ephraim and Daniel Waucom, all my pasture
ground that is contained within fence for their use and benefit I Give
and bequeath unto my Son Abraham Waucom and Daniel Waucom all my land that
lies upon the North Side of the main road for their use and benefit I Give
and bequeath unto all my Sons and daughters all my good and market of said Island, except
what is for a privilege for their use and benefit.
