

The Last Will and Testament of Arthur Bowden dead Exhibited in open Court at May Term 1832 proven by the Oaths of J. Waterfield & Timothy Bowden witnesses thereto & ordered to be Recorded.

In the name of God Amen I Arthur Bowden of the State of North Carolina and of Swain County being sick and weak but that my perfect senses and thanks be unto God for it calling unto mind the mortality of man have a mind to settle my worldly business in manner and form as follows do give by this my last will and testament.

First I want the yokes of steers sold for the benefit of settling of my Estate and my auger for the same being and also I give to my well beloved son Thos Bowden my English musket & to my son W. Bowden my French Musket

Item I give to my well beloved wife Sophia all the rest of my property both in doors and out doors lands & Chattel property her natural life for her use & her benefit to this my last will & testament when of I should set my hand & seal this the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December on this year Eight hundred & thirty one Arthur Bowden Seal

The Last Will and Testament of W. Berry died Exhibited in open Court at May term 1832 & proven by the Oaths of Jesse Ball & Samuel Ball witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded The Oaths Qualifyed

In the name of God Amen I William Berry of the County of Swain in the State of North Carolina being in perfect health of sound and disposing mind and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of human life and that it is appointed for man to die do make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner and form following.

Impoverished I give and bequeath to my sister Betsey Portwood the sum of Twenty five dollars and if she be dead before the same get to her to her son Howard Portwood if he should be dead to be divided to the rest of her children Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Betsey Berry all the Remainder of my estate within doors & without to her and to her disposal for ever

Lastly I will and desire that my beloved wife Betsey Berry be and are hereby constituted appointed and ordained whole and sole Executrix to this my last will & testament in witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 7<sup>th</sup> day of January 1831

The Last Will & Testament of Rachel Jarrel dead Exhibited in open Court at May Term 1832 & proven by the Oath of Caleb Tatum & witness thereto & ordered Recorded

In the name of God Amen I Rachel Jarrel of the County of Swain State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory (helped be God) do this the tenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty two make and publish this my last will & testament in manner following that is to say

First I want all my Just debts to be paid out of my estate & I give and bequeath to Sarah Brabble the whole of my estate within doors and without which shall have been left after paying my Just debts as aforesaid to her and her heirs forever

And I also make and ordain said Sarah Brabble Executrix to this my last will and testament In witness whereof I the said Rachel Jarrel have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal this day and date above written
