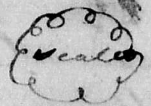


The last Will of ~~Asa Lee~~ and Testament of Asa Lee
 Asa Lee having my health in part but in sound
 Senses and Reason I resign my soul to God that gave
 me my body to be decently buried in a Christian manner
 I Give and bequeath all the land and which I now live to
 the two Children the Son of the daughter of my wife
 Franky Wright James and Thomas a also I Give
 and bequeath three negroes Tom, Ed and Nancy to
 the said James and Thomas the said land and negroes
 above mentioned to remain in the possession of my
 wife Mary Lee and her Daughter Franky Wright
 during their Natural life or widow hood but if they
 or either of them should marry this provided they shall
 leave and be no more I Give and bequeath unto my
 Grandson Stephen the Son of my Daughter Sally
 Lee the sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars to be
 paid in Gold or Silver or the Value thereof in the
 Currency of this State I Give and bequeath unto
 my son Frederick Lee thirty six and one half Dollars
 to be distributed to him at the discretion of the
 Executor all the Remainding part of my Real and
 Personal Estate I Give and bequeath unto my wife
 Mary and her Daughter Franky for her and their use
 and after their decease to the above mentioned James
 and Thomas this my last will and Testament
 I make this twenty fourth in the Year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred and ninety three

In the Name of God Amen I Peter Dange Do
 Make and Ordain this my Last Will & Testament
 in the first place to Give my soul to God in hope of things to
 come Christ. As to my worldly Estate I Give and bequeath
 in the following manner First I Give all my Land & Tenements Vizt
 Isaac Etheridge Philip and Samuel Dange and be
 Equally divided between my said three sons according
 to Quantity and Quality Secondly I Give unto my
 Daughter Elizabeth Sally Penny and Charity a
 Negro Girl named Eda. Whose Child nam'd Peggitt
 and their Increase to be Equally divided amongst
 them forever. Thirdly I Give unto my Two Sons Philip
 and Samuel a Negro boy March to them and
 their heirs forever. Fourthly I Give unto my loving
 wife Eliza one Negro man named Eda and a
 Negro woman named Eda and their
 heirs forever. I Give some Cows and Calves for ever
 All the Rest of property that Given Away my will is that
 it be Equally divided amongst all my Children Vizt
 Isaac Etheridge Philip Samuel Elizabeth Sally Penny
 and Charity I further will that a Negro Man named
 Johnston and a Negro Girl named Hannah be both
 sold I do also appoint and Ordain as my Executor to
 this my Last will Samuel Tucker in witness whereof
 I set my hand and seal affixed my Seal
