 One Tenth part, by the Name of Wandy, I Give
 unto my beloved daughter Barbara one Tenth part by the
 Name of Prindle I Give to my beloved daughter Anna
 one Tenth part by the Name of Wandy I Give unto
 my little Philip & Hogg, and all the rest of my Property in
 Doors & out that I have got since the separation of my
 Harbours, to them & their heirs, also I also constitute & appoint my
 Son Laban Mallum and my friend Ruben Mallum my
 whole and sole executor, to this my last will & Testament
 to Putte my bursep according to this my last will and
 Testament, & the law shall require, as witness my hand and
 Seal, this 5th Day of April 1800.

 I Give unto my daughter Charlotte one Cow by the Name of
 Herry, I Give unto my Son Philip one calf with a
 white foot I Give unto my daughter Hanny one Cow by the
 Name of Gentile one Bull big as killed my hogg I leave
 for the use of my wife and I make Priscilla my will &
 desire is that my loving wife Priscilla should have the use of all
 my house and hold furniture in doors and out doors, during her life or
 widow hood, & after her decease to be equally divided amongst my
 six Children above named, to them & their heirs, also I constitute &
 appoint my loving wife Priscilla and my Son William my
 whole & sole executor to this my last will & Testament to Putte all my
 bursep according to this my last will & Testament, & the law shall
 require as witness my hand & Seal, this 13th day of April in the
 Year of our Lord anno Dom. 1805.
