 son Charles Sears deceased one negro woman ^{named} Hildy & Children

all she haves now or will have to be equally divided between them
 and their heirs for ever. Item I give and bequath to my son
 Thomas Sears one negro man Sam to him and his heirs also
 one negro woman Abby and her child Dempsey & all her increase
 here after also one hundred dollars in cash or ^{the best home} ~~money~~ to him for
 ever. Item I give and bequath to my son William Sears all

the land & plantation where I now live to him and his heirs for
 ever. ^{also negro boy Jeffery to him & his heirs for ever}
^{Item I give to my son William Sears ~~the plantation~~}

After paying all my debts out of the estate that had not been given above
 I give to my two sons Thomas Sears & William Sears all the Residues
 of my estate between them to be divided Equally to them and their heirs
 for ever. I nominate constitute and appoint my two sons Thomas Sears
 & William Sears my & sole ~~estate~~ Executors to this my last will and Tes-

Item I leave part of my land to be sold to pay my debts
 beginning at the the corner of the cleared land at the main
 road from thence running a straight course with the ditch
 on the east side of the plantation to the creek from thence
 running up the creek to James Lees line thence with Lees
 line to the road thence with the road to the first station

Item I give all the remainder of my Land to my son James
 Sawyer to him and his heirs for ever. Lastly I leave my Bro-
 ther Joseph Sawyer my sole and sole executor of this my last
 will and testament in witness whereof I have ^{hereunto} set my hand
 and affixed my seal this the 16th day of March 1827
