Divided between my three Sons James and
Thomas and William ^W Sanderson & my wife
Polly Sanderson excepting my Banks Land
which I give Equally between my three boys or
sons as above named and if either my three sons
James, Thomas & William, ^J Sanderson die before
they have an heir of their body or come to lawfull
age the surviving one shall have part with-
out any Reserve whatever.

I do authorise my Executor hereafter mentioned to
Convey by a deed of his gain and sale to Thomas
Sanderson for a tract of Land in Pasquotank
County where John a Jordan Dec. formerly
lived upon Condition of Thomas Sanderson
paying to my said Executor the sum of Two
Thousand Dollars worth lawfull but from the
first day of November 1819 until paid up
and the same money to be applied to the paying
of a Debt I owe to the Estate or heirs of Willoughby
Foggs Dec. and the remainder of said money
I give unto my Grand Daughter Angelica -
Thorough good to her & her heirs forever.

I do nominate Constituted & appoint my Friend Thomas Payne
Exect of this my last will & Testament foraking and
disannulling all other wills or my hentes for by
me made in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & seal this the seventh day of Oct 1830

The Last will and Testament of Jacob Stuber Decd
May exhibited at May Term 1826 was written
so badly that it could not be read
correct enough to enter on Record, so original filed
The Last will and Testament of Joseph Stuber Decd
was exhibited at February Term 1821.
In the name of God Amen I Joseph Stuber of the
County of Currituck in the State of North Carolina
being sick in body but of sound and disposing
mind and memory blessed be God do this the Twenty
first day of February in the Year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and sixteen Maste
published and declare this instrument of writing to be
my last will and Testament in manner as follows
Item I had the use of the house wherein I now live
and as much of the Land after Sam. Stuber takes
his part off to my wife as he can and or one third
of it during her life and I also give her one feather
bed and furniture to her & her heirs forever also
I give to my wife Mary Stuber my feather bed when
I lie during her life also I give my wife an Horse
called Duke and my riding Chair to her and her
heirs forever also I had to my wife one negro girl
called Harriet and one negro boy called Jack
during his life also give her one Cow and Calf
at Home and one Cow in the Woods or back
Swamps also one Cow and猪 two first choice
and all the poultry and our black Table in
Dogen Hall one set Cups and Saucers one Iron
pot one Tea Kettle in Dogen setting Chair and
one pair of Dog Irons one looking Glass and all
the Box of furniture to her and her heirs forever
also one pair of fire tongs Steam Spork to last the
thy Year. Item I give and bequeath to my
son George Stuber and my son Peter

Subs after my wife Death my land and Plantation
whereon I now live to be equally Divided between
him and their heirs forever.

Item. I give to my daughter Betsey Cawell one cow
and Calf to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I give to my daughter Fances & John one cow
and Calf & I give Fernando Dill to be raised
out of my Estate to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath to my son Peter Subber
my Negro Boy Jack after my wifes death
and one cow Half lone Salt Peppa one

Sheath Bed & furniture to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I give to my daughter Charlotte Hunter
Lws Fernando Dill to be raised out of my
Estate Lone Peppa Hips & one round Mahogany
Table to her & her heirs forever.

Item. I give to my son George Subber my long
Curn Amy & Billy to him & his heirs forever.

Item. I give to Hillary Hunter my short Gun
to him & his heirs forever.

Item. By my will that my Land is bounded and all
the residue of my Property that has not been
willed away both within Doors & without shall
be sold and equally divide the money arising
therefrom after paying all my just Debts &
Between all my Children &

I also nominate and appoint my son George Subber and my
friend Mr. Simmons my Executrix to try my last will and
testament In witness whereof I the said Joseph
Subber the testator have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my Seal the day & date above written
by me sealed acknowledged &
Signed and in presence of us
McLammons & Cawell witnessed

The Last will & testament of Sarah
Lony Eschituted Feby 1st 1832

In the Name of God Amen I Sarah Lony being
sick & weak in body & my Mind fluctuating but perfect
in mind & memory as when in health thanks to my
God for the same & considering the uncertainty of life
think proper to make & ordain this to be my last
will & Testaments as followeth

Item 1st. I give & bequeath to John C. Simmons the
following Negroes, viz Daniel Nancy Pleasant Eliza
& Lamb but it is my request I desire that the ad
John C. Simmons will admit & Negroes to have the
result of their labour but ever to be under his
care & protection & his heirs forever.

Item 2nd. I give & bequeath to Black Water meeting
House for its repair or towards the building of a
new one as the Church may think proper fifty
dollars to be retained in the hands of my Exec. with
Interest until the building or repairing of Ad Meeting
House be completed.

Item 3rd. I give & bequeath to Maria Gibson one negro
boy named Daniel, one Buffet crockery & glassware
one Loom & harness, one Piggy to be sold & the money
arising therefrom one bed & furniture one dog stool
Chair, one blue Chest, also another bed & furniture
also one Mahogany Table one Great Wheel & one
Young Wheel & $\frac{3}{4}$ of the net proceeds of my Estate
after paying all just debts & Legacies to her &
her heirs forever.

Item 4th. I give & bequeath to Eliza Bojer one bed
& furniture 3rd choice to her & her heirs forever.

Item 5th. I give & bequeath to Susan Bojer one Bed
& furniture 4th choice to her & her heirs for-
ever.

Item 6th. I give & bequeath to Brother in Law Lewis Lony
 $\frac{1}{4}$ of the money arising from my Estate after
paying all just debts & Legacies to him & his heirs forever.
