and the one half of my schooner Con Stanton
to her & to her heirs forever and two boys had molasses
them I have all the remainder of all my house
hold & kitchen furniture and plantation furniture
and all the remainder of my negroes and
stock of all kinds and all the rest or remainder
of my estate after my debts is paid to be equally
divided between my three sons James and
Thomas and William & Canderson & my wife
Sally Canderson excepting my Banks Land
which I give equally between my three boys or
sons as above named and if either my three sons
James, Thomas & William, or Canderson die before
they have an heir of their body or come to law
age the surviving one shall their parts with-
out any reserved matters.

I do authorize my Executor hereafter mentioned to
convey by a deed of bargain and sale to Thomas
Barnes for a tract of Land in Pasquotank
County where John a Jordan Dec^d formerly
lived upon condition of Thomas Barnes
paying to my said Executor the sum of two
thousand Dollars with lawful interest from the
first day of November 1819 until paid up
and the said money to be applied to the paying
of a Debt I owe to the estate or heirs of Milledge
Gozier Dec^d and the remainder of said money
I give unto my Grand Daughters Angeline -
Thorough good to her & her heirs forever.

I do nominate constitute & appoint my Friend Thomas Bynum
Exec^r of this my last will & Testament foraking and
disannulling all other wills or wills here before by
me made in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & seal this the seventh day of Oct 1820

The Last will and Testament of Capt Storer Dec^d
was exhibiting at May Term 1820. was written
so badly that it could not be read
correct enough to enter an Record, so original filed
The Last will and Testament of Joseph Stuber Dec^d
was exhibited at February Term 1821.

In the name of God Amen I Joseph Stuber of the
County of Currituck in the State of North Carolina
being sick in body but of sound and disposing
mind and memory. Hope be God do this the Twentieth
last day of February in the Year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and sixteen Make
public and declare this instrument of writing to be
my last will and Testament in manner as follows
I leave the use of the house wherein I now live
and as much of the Land after said Stuber takes
his part off to my wife as she can use or one third
of it during her life and I also give her one feather
bed and furniture to her & her heirs forever also
I leave to my wife Mary Stuber my Feather bed and
I leave during her life also I give my mill an Horse
called Luke and my riding Chair to her and her
heirs forever also I leave to my wife one negro Girl

called Harriet and one negro boy called Jack
during her life also give her one cow and calf
at home and one cow in the woods or back
swamp also one sow and piggs first choice
and all the poultry and one black table &
Dozen Plates one set cups and saucers one iron
pot one Tea Kettle & Dozen sitting Chair and
one pair of Dog Iron one looking Glass and all
the Bofat furniture to her and her heirs forever
also one pair of fine tongs & one Spoon to last her
the Year. I give and bequeath to my
son George Stuber and my son Peter

Reuben after my wife's Death my land and Plantation
whereon I now live to be equally Divided between
him and their Heirs forever

Item I give to my daughter Betsey Cawel one cow
and a calf to her and her heirs forever

Item I give to my daughter Fancis ~~the~~ John one cow
and a calf & I give Amaro Dally to be raised
out of my Estate to her and he lives forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son Peter Reuben
my negro Boy Jack after my wife's death
and one cow & calf one salt & pepper one
feather bed & furniture to him and his heirs forever

Item I give to my daughter Charlotte Reuben
two Amaro Dallys to be raised out of my
Estate one Pepp Heifer & one sound mahogany
Table to her & her heirs forever

Item I give to my son George Reuben my long
Gun & my Bible to him & his heirs forever

Item I give to Hellary Reuben my Short Gun
to him & his heirs forever

Item My will that my Land in Camden and all
the Issues of my Property that has not been
willed away both within Doors & without shall
be sold and equally divide the money arising
herefrom after paying all my just Debts to
Believers all my Children &c

I also nominate and appoint my son George Reuben and my
friend M. Simmons my Executors to this my Last will and
Testament In witness whereof I the said Joseph
Reuben the testator have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my Seal the day & date above written
Signed sealed & acknowledged
in presence of us

The Last will and testament of Sarah Loney Episcopite July Term 1832

In the Name of God Amen I Sarah Loney being
Sick & weak in body & my Mind fluctuating but perfect
in mind & memory as when in health thanks to my
God for the same & considering the uncertainty of life
think proper to make & ordain this to be my last
will & Testament as Followeth

Item 1st I give & bequeath to John C. Simmons the
following Negroes viz Daniel Nancy Pleasant Eliza
& Lamb but it is my request & desire that the sd
John C. Simmons will admit sd negroes to have the
result of their labour but ever to be under his
care & protection & his heirs forever

Item 2^d I give & bequeath to Black Water Meeting
House for its repair or towards the building of a
new one as the Church may think proper fifty
dollars to be retained in the hands of my Exrs without
Interest until the building or repairing of sd Meeting
House be complete

Item 3^d I give & bequeath to Maria Gibson one negro
boy named Daniel, one Buffel Crockery & a half ware
one Loom & harness, one fluff to be sold & the money
arising therefrom one bed & furniture one dog stool
chairs, one blue Chest, also another bed & furniture
also one Mahogany Table one meat Wheel & one
Criming Wheel & 1/4th of the net proceeds of my Estate
after paying all just debts & Legacies to her &
her heirs forever

Item 4th I give & bequeath to Eliza Boyer one bed
& furniture 3 choice to her & her heirs forever

Item 5th I give & bequeath to Susan Boyer one bed
& furniture 4 choice to her & her heirs for-

ever
Item 6th I give & bequeath to Mother in Law Samms Loney
1/4 of the money arising from my Estate after
paying all just debts & Legacies to him & his heirs forever
