 And State of North Carolina. Calling to mind the uncertainty of this
 life it being Ordained for all men Once to Die Do make and Ordain
 this my last will and Testament. first that is to say I recommend
 my soul to Almighty God. that gave it and my body to be buried
 in a Christian like manner. And as to what Estate it hath been
 pleas'd God to give me. I give and Dispose in manner and form
 as followeth. my wife and Desire is that my well beloved wife
 Sarah should have the use of all my Lands During her widow
 hood Not to cut no timber Only for the use of the Plantation.
 I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah the land and
 Plantation that I bought of Samuel Seay During her natural
 life I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah one negro girl
 I leave to her and her heirs forever. I give and bequeath to my wife
 Sarah one negro girl Return. During her widowhood I give
 and bequeath to my wife Sarah one horse by the name of Jennie
 to her and her heirs forever. I give & bequeath to my wife Sarah half
 of all my moveable property During her natural life I mean one
 half of the Cash & other hand & that is Due me also...
 I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Bennett all my
 lands to her and her heirs forever. And if she should Die without
 issue of her body to return to my well beloved wife Sarah Bennett
 I also give one half of all my moveable property to my wife
 Daughter Elizabeth Bennett to her and her heirs forever. But in case
 she should Die without heirs to return to my beloved wife Sarah Bennett

Warrant I give one half of the Cash in hand and that is Due
 me to Daughter Elizabeth Bennett to her and her heirs forever. But in
 case she should Die without heirs of her body to return to my wife
 Sarah Bennett at her own Disposal Also the Negro Girl that I
 gave to my Daughter Elizabeth Bennett in case she should Die
 without heirs of her body to return to my beloved wife at her own
 Disposal my wife and Desire is that my beloved wife should bleach
 and school my Daughter Elizabeth Bennett sufficiently until she is
 raised And to make no charge for the same when once my wife should
 be pregnant my wife and Desire is that the Child should come in
 for an equal part of all my lands and moveable property to that
 And make heirs forever. I constitute my trusty friend Joseph
 Wallentine my whole and sole Executor to this my last will and
 Testament. to see all my Estate settled according as the Law I shall
 Direct As writings whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 4th Day
 of February 1799.
