who gave it and my body I recommend to the earth  
to be buried in a decent manner Nothing doubting but of the  
General Resurrection. I shall receive the same again by  
the Mighty Power of God, so teaching such worldly estate  
Whichever of both Pleas God, to bless my estate in this  
life, I Give demise and dispart of the same in the  
following manner. Item I Give and bequeath unto Sarah  
Dorcas one Dow and 25. also I Give and bequeath unto  
Dorcas O. David daughter of William O. David one  
Dow and 25. also I Give and bequeath one Dow and  
25. unto my son James O. David, and I also wish the  
same to be sold Item I Give and bequeath unto my  
son John O. David and Thomas O. David a  
Certain Messuage of land where they now live on the Mannors  
Shope to be equally divided between them both he the  
same more or less to them and their heirs forever  
Item I also give and bequeath unto my son William O. David  
A Certain tract or messuage of land lying on North River swamp  
the same more or less where he now lives to be divided  
between him and his daughter Dorcas to them and their heirs forever  
also I Give and bequeath the manors plantation to be equally  
divided between my son William O. David and James O. David  
to them and their heirs forever their lands messuages and tenements  
Right them to be paid and enjoyed and I do hereby utterly  
disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former  
testament, wills, legacies, bequeaths and Gifts by me in any wise  
before named, written and bequeathed, ratifying and confirming  
this and no other to be my last will and testament in witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 5<sup>th</sup> day of  
December 1803. signed sealed and delivered and declared this to be his  
last will and testament in the presence of us.

State of N. C. County of Kentucky being now in my right mind  
and memory thanks to God but knowing it is appointed for all  
Men once to die I therefore make and establish this continued  
of writing to be my last will and testament in manner and  
form as follows and first I recommend my soul into the hands  
of God that gave it me and my body to the hands of  
Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner and then  
I recommend my debts debts to be paid out of my estate  
Item I then lend to my beloved wife Mary Hunt the whole of  
my estate during her natural life and widowhood and  
at my wife's death over and above my will and desire is  
that the whole of my estate should be sold at public  
Sale and the money applied to the use of my three sons  
Lena and Lucenna and Debby I also constitute and  
appoint my beloved wife Mary Hunt to be my whole sole  
Power to this my last will and testament revoking all  
Others in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
seal this 11th day of January 1804 signed sealed and  
delivered in the presence of the Subscribing
