I Memoriall you following Trust. I give My Soul to him who gave it Me and My body to be buried in a Christian like Manner, and My Estate I dispose of in formans Manner following Viz —
Imprimis, I give and bequeath to My brother Calb Parr, the one half of all My Estate, after My wife's decease.

Item, I give and bequeath to My brother John Parr, the one fourth of all my estate, after My wife's decease.

Item, I give and bequeath, to Richard Hutchings, Son of James Hutchings, the one fourth of my property, after My wife's decease, should Richard Hutchings, Son of James Hutchings die, without any surviving heir lawfully begotten of his Body, then My Will and desire is that his part of my estate, devolve to My Brother Calb Parr.

I also appoint my friend Samuel Dugay, to be My whole and sole executor, of this My last will and Testament, to settle all my business, agreeable to this will, and as the case shall admit, to contrive, to him unto set. My hand and seal this the eight day of August, 1803,

I Thomas Durkin of Cape Hatteras Bank Plot, being very sick & weak in body but of perfect Mind and Memory thanks be given to God, Calling into mind the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for for all men once to die as man, I Ordain this My last will and Testament, That is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, that gave it and My body I recommend to the Earth to be Buried decently Christian burial, at the discretion of my Executor, and as Touching such worldly Estates, wherewithal it hath pleased Almighty God to bless me with, in this life, I give away and dispose of the same in following Manner, And form, First I give and bequeath to Mary Steyn, who is now living with me, all the Cows from William Dwyers Cows to Rubber Burner Line with all the houses and household furniture and my Negro boy Jack to her son or her heirs forever, likewise I give Anne her freedom, at my death, likewise I give Mary Steyn, One Mare called Spring, with Two Cows and Calves, to her and her heisspower, likewise I give to my Sister Sarah Durkin, One Cow and Calf, and the rest of my property to be sold, to pay my debts, all my Lands and other property, that is not named in my will, and if anything then left, after my just debts are paid, I leave it to my Sister Sarah, likewise I make the Ordain Rubber Burner sole Executor, to this My last will and Testament, and as hereby directed, disannul and revoke all and every other will and Testament bequeath and Executor, by me in any wise before mentioned, and Confirming this and no other to be My last will and Testament, In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and Seal, this Twenty Second day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and One.
