Mind and Memory, do Make and Ordain this to be My last Will and Testament,
In Manner and form following. First, I Give My Soul to Almighty God who
Gave it Me and My body to be buried in a Christian like Manner, and My
Estate I dispose of in form and Manner, following. VIZ. —
I Give and bequeath to My brother Caleb Parr, the One half of all
My Estate, after My Wife's decease.

I Give and bequeath to My brother Jesse Parr, the One fourth of all my estate,
after My Wife's decease.

I Give and bequeath to Richard Huthings, Son of James Huthings, the One
Fourth of My Property, after My Wife's decease. Should Richard Huthings, Son
of James Huthings die, without any Surviving him lawfully begotten of his
Body, then My Will and desire is that his Part of My estate, devolve to My
Brother Caleb Parr.

I Also appoint My friend Samuel Dager, to be My whole and Sole executor,
of this My last Will and Testament, to settle all my business, Agreeable to
This Will, and as the Case shall direct, In Witness Whereof, I do hereunto Set
My Hand and Seal this the Ninth day of August, 1804.

Thomas Dasher of Cape Hatteras Banks Plot, being
Very Sick and weak in body but of perfect Mind and Memory thanks be given to God,
Calling into Mind the Mortality of My body and knowing that it is appointed for
For all Men Once to die, do Make and Ordain this My last Will and Testament,
That is to say Principally and first of all I Give and Recommend my Soul into the
Hands of Almighty God, that gave it And My body I Recommend to the Earth to be
Buried in a Christian burial, at the discretion of my Executors, and as
Touching such worldly Estate, wherewith it hath pleased Almighty God to bless
Me with, in this life I Give divide and dispose of the Same in following Manner
And form. First I Give and bequeath to Mary Styer, who is now living with
Me, all the Land from William Daidley's Line to Reuben Burrus's Line with
all the houses and household furniture and My Negro boy Jack to her and hers
Ains forever likewise I Give Chanc her freedom, at My death, likewise I Give
Mary Styer, One Mare Called Spring, with Two Cows and Calves to her and
her heirs forever. Likewise I Give to My Sister Sarah Dasher, One Cow and
Calf, and the Rest of My Property to be Sold, to pay My debts, all my Taxes and
other Property, that is not taken in My Will. And if any thing then left, after
My Just debts is all paid, I leave it to My Sister Sarah, likewise I make
And Ordain Reuben Burrus Sole Executor, to this My last Will and Testament,
And as hereby directions, disannul and revoke all and every other Will and
Testament bequest and Executor, by me in any wise before Mentioned, and
Confirming this and no other to be My last Will and Testament, In Witness
Whereof, I have hereunto Set My Hand and Seal, this Twenty Second day of
September in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and One.
