I Give all the rest of my Estate to my well beloved Wife Mary Campbell during her natural life and then to be Equally Divided Between my Children Leave and appoint my Wife Mary Campbell & Willis Strong my sole and sole Executors to this my last will & Testament in Witness whereunto I set my hand and seal my seal this the 14th day of the 1st month of the year 1774.
