The Last Will and Testament of David Jones
Deceased was in Open Court Exhibited Read and
the Respective Circulars Read by taking the
Oath by Law Provided all in due form of Law
and was Read to be recorded, as follows

In the Name of God Amen. March the 22 Day
1773 I David Jones of the County of Currituck being
of full age and of sound Mind and disposing
Mind
do make and Ordain this my last Will Testament
in Writing and form following that is to say
Infirmities I have all my Estate within Doors and
Without Doors be it real and Personal to be by my
Executors herein named for Me sold at Publick
Vendue for Six Months Credit and the Money
arising from such Sales after my just Debts paid
to be Divided in the following Manner that is to
say two thirds thereof to my Son William Henry
Jones and his Heirs forever and the other third to my
Wife Elizabeth Jones and her Heirs forever.
Item I have my Son William Henry Jones under the immediate
Protection Care and Tutorship of Francis Williamson
untill he my said Son shall arrive to the Age of
Twentyone Years. I the said will and Desire that

my Son William Henry Jones his Estate shall
be by the said Tutor let out on Lawfull Interest for
the benefit of my said Son
I the said do nominate and appoint Francis Williamson
and Solomon Perkins to be my whole and sole Execu-
tors to this my last Will and Testament according and
accordingly all former and other Will and Testaments
made by me in Writing of which I sign Seal pronounce
and Declare this to be and contain my last Will
and Testament.
