House for its repair or towards the building of a
new one as the Church may think proper fifty
dollars to be retained in the hands of my Ex^{or} without
Interest until the building or repairing of sd Meeting
House be completed.

Item 3^d I give & bequeath to Maria Gibson one negro
boy named Daniel, one Buffet Crockery & Glass ware
one Loom & harrow, one Hogg to be sold & the money
arising therefrom one bed & furniture one dog stool
Chairs, one blue Chest, also another bed & furniture
also one Mahogany Table one Sreat Wheel & one
Sewing Wheel & $\frac{3}{4}$ th of the net proceeds of my Estate
after paying all just debts & Legacies to her &
her heirs forever.

Item 4th I give & bequeath to Eliza Boyer one bed
& furniture 3^d choice to her & her heirs forever.

Item 5th I give & bequeath to Susan Boyer one Bed
& furniture 4th choice to her & her heirs for-

ever.
Item 6th I give & bequeath to Brother in Law Lewis Loney
 $\frac{1}{4}$ of the money arising from my Estate after
paying all just debts & Legacies to him & his heirs forever.

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I also nominate & appoint my Friend John Wright my whole
& sole Executor to this my last will & Testament re-
-voking all others heretofore by me made

one young negro man by the name of March one
negro woman by the name of Betsey and Child by the
name of Mary the negro girl Lemon that I have
lent to my wife till she comes to 15 years of age
I give to my daughter Caroline after the expiration
of the 15 years -

I give and bequeath to my wife 10 head of sheep I desire
that my just debts to be paid and all the residue of my
money to go to my daughter Caroline Lawyer
I make and Ordain my worthy friend Caleb Lawyer
