

Will & Testament of Dennis Capps deceased Hands thus Vizt.

In the name of God Amen I Henry the 12 day of 1762 I Dennis Capps of Brunswick County and partment of North Carolina being well Stricken in years but in perfect senses and knowing that this be to God for the bridge and knowing the uncertainty of this transitory life and that it is appointed due for all men to die am minded to settle my affairs in manner and form following that is to say I do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament and first and principally I give and bequeath my soul unto God so his good will please that through the merits of Jesus Christ my Redeemer I shall receive forgiveness and redemption for all my sins and my Body to be Buried in the earth in such decent and Christian manner as my Executors hereafter mentioned shall think meet and convenient and as for that worldly goods God in his Mercy hath lent unto me I give and Bequeath as followeth I am I Give and Bequeath unto my son Caleb Capps my monster plantation where on I live containing one hundred and fifty seven acres of Land and ten shillings to him and his heirs for ever and if my said son should die without lawful issue of his body that it should fall to my son Edward Capps and his heirs for ever I am I give unto my son Caleb Capps one (sother Bed and furnished me) one table one large Dish of Plate and five and my gun and one pair of a pair of Coat wheels and young horse and saddle two cows and calves two hogs and pigs one lid and Lamb I am I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Capps one Bed of furniture of one Duffail Chast and one Dish and seven of Plate one foot wheel and Iron pot of one Rachel two two year old Horses one year and one for to be delivered to her sister the Comes of twelve years old I am I give and Bequeath unto my son Dennis Capps my small plantation where I live containing sixty acres to him for ever and I leave my silver box between my sons Dennis and Edward Capps of my Horse Collar and one young pig I am I give of Bequeath unto my son Edward Capps one young mare and one Lamb one Come and my Carpenters Tools I am I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Milbra I will one Cow and calf one young steer one Fish I am I give and Bequeath unto my son Dennis Capps eight by acres of Land called Hecar Ridge and the Rest of what I Leave to be equally divided betwixt my Wife and her two Children (turn over) Also I do give Thomas Dudley and Caleb Capps my hole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 12 day of January 1762
