My will and desire is and I do hereby authorize and empower my Executor after my death to sell at publick sale for six months credit the land and plantation that I bought of William Harrington del^d, and the money or notes arising from the sale of said tract of land I give unto my son Thomas White son William White, and daughters Peggy Woodhouse and Nancy Mercer, to be equally divided between them share and share alike, to them and their heirs forever. Item I give unto my son Thomas White, my son William White and my daughter Nancy. Never three negroes named Daniel, Bridget and Tom, to equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever. Item I give unto my sons Thomas and William White and my daughters Peggy Woodhouse and Nancy Mercer, all the remainder part of my estate that I have not already given away, of what kind or nature soever, to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever. Lastly I appoint my wife Bridget White and Thomas White sons, my whole and sole Executors. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Arthur Northern the plantation and swamp that I purchased of my son James Northern, it being the land whereon I now live, to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Doratha Foster one bed and furniture, one cow and calf to her and her heirs. Item I give and bequeath unto my grand son Harry Wilson one cow and calf to him and his heirs. Item I give and bequeath unto my grand son Percy Wilson one cow and calf to him and his heirs. Item I give and bequeath unto my grand son Miles Wilson one cow and calf, to him and his heirs

Item I give the residue of my property not already given away unto my son George Northern to him and his heirs. Lastly I do nominate and appoint my two sons Arthur and George Northern Executors to this my last will and Testament. The last will and Testament of Jesse Capps deceased exhibited
and proved at November Term 1819
In the name of God, Amen. The twenty seventh September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen. I Jesse Capps of the state of North Carolina in the county of Currituck, being in a perfect and sound mind, but weak in body, therefore calling into mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, that is to say; Principally and first of all, I give and recommend my soul in the hands of God that gave it, and for my body I recommend it to the earth to be buried in a christian and decent like manner at the discretion of my Executor, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall again receive the same by the mighty power of God, and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bestow me with in this life, I give and devise and dispose of the same in manner and form as following. I will and desire that it is my will, that all of my just debts and funeral expences be paid first of all. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha Capps all the land that I hired from her on Hoods Point and Mackin Island. Also I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha Capps one negro woman by the name of Fule, and one negro child by the name of Emaline, and one negro man by the name of Shadrach; also I give to my beloved wife Martha Capps all of my household and kitchen furniture; also I give all my crop in doors and out doors to my beloved wife Martha Capps, also I give my house unto my wife and all of my hogs and cattle, to her and her heirs forever; also I give unto my beloved wife Martha Capps ally my shup, to her and her heirs forever. Lastly I nominate and constitute and appoint my beloved wife Martha Capps my whole and sole Executrix to this my last will and Testament, to see the same done and performed.
