

The last Will and Testament of Mafamilian Miller Exhibits and proved at May Term 1824

In the name of God Amen I Mafamilian Miller being of sound and perfect mind & memory blest be to God do this 3rd of February 1824 in the year of our Lord 1824 make this my last will & Testament in manner following that is to say first I bequeath all my just debts to be paid then I bequeath all my property to my dear beloved wife so long as she lives my widow or life then after the death or marriage of my well beloved wife I want and bequeath my son Evan Miller one tenth & Cyphering state and five dollars to be raised out of my estate then I bequeath unto William Miller and Caleb Miller being my two sons one negro girl named Chana to have and to hold their heirs forever then I bequeath after the death of their Mother the balance to be equally divided among my three sons Evan William & Caleb Miller I leave my dear wife to settle my estate in manner and form as given under my hands and seal this the 3rd of February 1824

The Last Will and Testament of Edmy Perkins Exhibits and Proved February Term 1824

In the name of God Amen I Edmy Perkins of the county of Cumberland being sick and weak in body and knowing that it is appointed for all to die do make this as my last will and Testament as follows.

Item I give to my two daughters Ana & Rhoebe Perkins one negro girl called Little Bet to them and their heirs.

I give to my daughter Ana Perkins one feather bed and other kind furniture to have her first choice to her and hers

I give to my daughter Rhoebe Perkins one feather bed and furniture to have the second choice to her and her heirs.

I give to my son Solomon Perkins one feather bed and two sheets as bed quilt to him and his heirs forever I give to my son Alfred Perkins one young mare to him and his heirs forever I give to my son Pharoah Perkins thirty dollars to be raised out of my estate I give to my daughter Angelica Ethridge one Linen Mill called Mine all the remainder of my estate I desire may be sold by my executor and equally divided among all my daughters last I appoint my friend Samuell Tubee my executor to this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 14th day of October 1823

The last will and Testament of Sampson Ethridge Exhibits February Term 1824.

In the name of God Amen

Sampson Ethridge of Cumberland County State of Maryland being in a low state of health but of a sound mind and memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in the manner and form following that is to say first of all I commend my soul in the care of Almighty God who first gave it & my will is for my body at my death to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executor and as touching what worldly estate it has pleased God to bless me with in this world I give and dispose of in manner and form following

Item 1. I give to my son Sampson Ethridge fifty acres of land to be laid off and situated on the east side of my plantation

Item 2. I give to my son William Ethridge fifty acres of land to be laid off and situated on the west side of my plantation

Item 3. I give to my son Nathan Ethridge fifty acres of land to be laid off and situated on the North West part of my plantation

Item 4. I also give to my son Nathan Ethridge one negro boy named George

Item 5. I give to my daughter Ana Ethridge one negro girl named Nancy

Item 6. I give to my daughter Susan Ethridge one negro girl called Abrispa

I give to my daughter Polly one negro boy named Solomon

I give to my daughter Polly Ethridge one negro woman called Lydia

I give to my son Thomas Ethridge one negro boy called Daniel

I leave to my beloved wife Elizabeth Ethridge the use and benefit of all my real and personal estate which she is to keep undisturbed during her natural life or Widowhood also she is not to bring any charge against any of my children for their Support or schooling I wish for my negro man Phillip to be sold for ready money to be applied to paying my last of all I nominate constitute and fully appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth Ethridge my whole and sole Executor to this my last will and Testament As Witness I have hereunto set my hands and affixed my seal this the 30th day of July A.D. 1822
