do dispose of what worldly Estate it hath pleased God to Bless me in Manner & following

"I gave and devise unto my sister Elizabeth Williams all my Right Title & Interest of and to
that Tract of Land, the Remainder of Lewis & Jarvis being five hundred & thirty Acres
which was given to me by my Mother's bequest to her with her in her last Will & Testament
bearing & being in Queen Anne's County Maryland, at County the said Lewis & Jarvis to her
with her personal life, and after her death to my Brother Thomas de Williams, to him and
his heirs lawfully begotten for ever, and the said Lewis & Jarvis to approved my friend Thomas Williams
a regular and true copy of this Verdy receiving all others by me made, In testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the 24 Day of May One thousand seven hundred thirty
and six

& all Item I give & bequeath all my Chancel Hoag & Sheep & House hold
goods to be equally divided amongst my six Children at the time that they marry
and I do nominate thus my last Will & Testament this twelfth Day of September
In the year of our Lord yet One thousand seven hundred and sixty eight

and I do nominate this my last Will & Testament this twelfth day of September
In the year of our lord God one thousand seven hundred and sixty eight

From My Decease & that my son Jacob shall enjoy the above half of my Land & the Myself
with From My Decease & bequeath all my Chattel Hogs & Sheep & Cattle & Horses & Towns
and to be equally divided amongst my six Children at the Time when they shall marry
and I do nominate this my last Will & Testament this Twelfth Day of September
in the year four and forty One thousand seven hundred and sixty eight

From this Date is that my son Jacob shall enjoy the other half of your Land & his heirs
2^d with From & give & bequeath all my Chattel ^{to} my son & heirs, the same
goods to be equally divided amongst my six Children at the Time when I shall be dead
and to be divided thus my last Will & Testament the twelfth Day of September
In the year four and forty one thousand seven hundred and sixty eight

and I do nominate you my last will & testament this twelfth day of September
in the year of our lord God one thousand seven hundred and sixty-eight
