The Last Will & Testament of Joseph Bell
Deed proved at February Term 1831

I give the use of my land & plantation to my beloved wife Elizabeth Bell during her natural life and after her decease I give and bequeath the aforesaid land & plantation to Dennis West son of young Willoughby West to him & his heirs forever.
I then I give to my sister Sally Bell Twenty five dollars to be raised out of my estate - I then I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Bell all the remainder of my property after paying my just debts to her and her heirs forever - Lastly I nominate and appoint my trusty friend Jonah Joliff
