 Within Doors and without Doors to my Wife Thamer Parr not
 to be enjoyed during her natural life and
 after her death to be equally and indifferently
 divided between my Children Richard Parr, William Parr,
 Thamer Parr, and Sarah Parr to them and their heirs for-
 ever. I also appoint my Wife Thamer Parr, and my
 son Richard Parr, to be my Executors and sole Executors of this
 my last Will and Testament to settle all my Business
 according to this Will and as the Law shall direct.
 In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 affixed my seal this 22nd day of July in the Year of our
 Lord 1805.

I Selwalachi a Slave of the County of Currituck State of
 North Carolina being in Reasonable Health and sound Mind
 & Memory do hereby bequeath unto my Son Selwalachi
 the Use of my Body & knowing that it is appointed for
 all men once to die, do make & declare this to be my last
 Will & Testament in manner & form following. To wit
 First of all I Give & Recommend my Soul to Almighty God
 that I have to trust my Body to be Buried in a Christian
 like manner at the discretion of my Executors. And I do
 hereby declare that I have with it hath pleased Al-
 mighty God to bless me with in this World, I Give & dispose of
 in the following manner

345. I Give & bequeath unto my two Sons John & James
 Parr, All my Lands to be equally divided between them
 my Executors to them & their heirs for ever.
 I Give & bequeath unto my two Sons John & James Parr all
 one hundred Dollars each to be raised by my Executors out
 of my movable property after my death to them their heirs
 forever. I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter
 Pathera Parr the Remainder part of my Estate not already
 Given away to her & her heirs forever. I do hereby
 Appoint & nominate Thomas Payne Executor of this my last
 Will & Testament (and also my Son Selwalachi Parr) to
 be appointed by the Court as Guardian to my Children within
 (named) & by the Court & disallowing all other wills
 Wills testifying this to be my last Will & Testament
 I do hereby certify that I have hereunto set my
 hand & Seal this 11th day of October 1805

 within my Mind in my Right Mind & of a disposing
 memory think it proper to make this my last will and tes-

 I Give the Use of fifteen Heads of cattle to my wife Barbara West
 & her heirs also the Use of all my Lands and plantations and also
 the privilege to cut timber for the support of the family during
 her widowhood. I Give all the Remainder of my
 Stock of Cattle to be sold and also as much of my personal
 such Articles as my Family Can best spare as well paying my
 lawful Debts to the said my Executors and a certain

months also in case that my Negro man Manahatt should be
proven a runaway and not brought back my wife and family
which have my consent to take said paper as private and
and apply the money to purchasing a school for the maintenance
of my four Daughters. I do after my lawful wife
and the business of settling my estate is kind to my will
and paper is that my wife deborah West shall have the
use of all the remainder of my estate both within doors
and without of every nature and kind during her widowhood
and at the expiration of her widowhood then to go to my
four Daughters namely Elizabeth and Rebecca and Lycia &
Amelia that or those that are living at that time.

I do give and bequeath unto son Stephen West all my land
laying on the East side of the main Road being the plantation
where I lived and the plantation I bought of Wills my
merchant and also one half of my marshland also
my title also my Sussex my apple tree also my hand
mill also my Negro John Kimo Nor to him and his heirs
for ever. I do give and bequeath unto my son
Cornelius West all the Kemo side of my land and plant-
ation laying on the West side of the main Road also one
half of my marshland to him and his heirs for ever.

I do give my tract of Land laying in Norfolk County
in the State of Virginia called Lower Woods to be sold by my
Executor. The Publick Auction on a Credit of six Months &
the proceeds to be Equally divided between my four Daughters
namely Elizabeth & Rebecca and Lycia and Amelia West to
them and their heirs for ever. Then I give and bequeath all
the remainder of my estate which is not already given
to my two sons to be Equally divided between my four Daughters
or the survivors, at the expiration of my wife's widowhood according
to her will and life satisfying and performing this to my
last will and testament. I do hereby do the Norfolk and ap-
point and ordain my friend John Bell my sole and sole
Executor of this my last will and testament in witness
where I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of
October 1807
