hath in possession to her & her Heirs for ever —

Item I give to my daughter Sally Williams Two Negroes viz
Agent & Nedde, and one bed & furniture to her & her Heirs
forever —

Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Williams Two Negroes viz
Elisha & David one Horse & one bed & furniture to her & her Heirs
forever —

The residue of my Estate Negro & I give to be equally divided
between my four Sons William Williams, Tulle Williams,
Hollowell Williams and Thomas Swan Williams, to them & their
Heirs forever —

Item I give to my Sister (if she will except of him) Negro
Narc Thomas —

and Lastly I appoint my Son John Lighten
Williams and Worthy Friend Thos Merchant whole & sole
Executors of this my Will & Testament and request Mr
Merchant to take care of Thos & and my Son to take care of
Hollowell, the other two to be put to some honest calling
as they may think best, and request my Son & Friend to
act in such a manner that we Slavey may have abundly
Meeting woe parting it no more through the all sufficient
Blood of Christ the Redeemer of the world in whom we
I do believe in — This 7th day of April 1794

& State of North Carolina being weak in Body but of perfect mind and
memory beseech God for the same and do make & publish this my last
Williams Testament in Manner as follows that it to say

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Simon sinkins the land and
Plantation wherons I now live to him and his heirs forever also give
Simon sinkins my horse Coll and bed Quen with all my bed and
bed feather bed and furniture and hand Mill three best Chests the best
Chust and all my tools to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Esekil sinkins the land and
Plantation that I had of John Lee that William Marst now live
on to him and his Heirs forever and my mare Coll large Chest a bed
Table three Chests one feather bed and furniture

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Peggy all the Movable pro-
perty she has now in her possession without claim to her mother
Heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Betsy sinkins one bed
(and furniture) two Kettles one white & one Cow to her and her Heirs forever —

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Deborah sinkins one red Cow
one pott and Kettle with all her Mothers Cloathes to her and her Heirs forever

Item I give unto my daughter Mary sinkins one Shilling Specie

Item I give my Brother to be equally divided between Simon Esekil
and Dinah sinkins the rest of my Estate I leave to be sold to defray
Lawful charges and the benefit of my small Children and I leave
my trusty friend John Captt my hole & one sole Executor to this
my last Will and Testament utterly denying and revoking all other
will or wills bearing Confirming and Establishing this my
last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal my seal this twenty sixth day of September
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety
four
