my last will and testament in manner following that is to say
I do bequeath to my Daughter Minney Acklands five thirty Dollars
I do bequeath one Table one Chest one Dish and Platter one plate
which she has in possession also one saw shot & half the old
saw & one third part of all my Flax during her life and if she
dies without a lawful issue I give the said flax to be equally
divided between her Brothers and Sisters I do bequeath to my
Daughter Eliza Smith one of her beds of Furniture two Chests
one Table one Dish one Spoon one Basin one plate one pot one
kettle one cup about the house & half my old cow one spinning
wheel one looking glass & two thirds of my
Flax during her life & at her death I give all the property
that is left to said Elizabeth to her son & daughter Eliza Smith
to gether with one Barrel of Corn to him & his heirs for ever
I do bequeath to my son Solomon Jarvis my old Bed
Furniture & my smallest Table & Basket & one Dish
and one gallon Basin & one small cow to him & his heirs for ever
I do bequeath to my son Ebenezer Jarvis my Bed & Father
Bed & Platter one walnut Chest & my biggest Table one Chair
mill one Kettle & Bettle & Gallon Basin & Dish & six plates
& my best Iron pot & Kettle & Tea kettle & pot & Hammer & all the
Rest of my Hogs and the rest of my Eggs & my best pork Barrel
to him and his heirs for ever I do leave all the Rest of
my property after paying my debts to be equally divided be-
tween my two Daughters Elizabeth Smith & Eliza Smith
to them & their heirs for ever And hereby make make
ordain my friend & Attorney Samuel Simmons Esq. to be my
last will & testament in witness whereof I the said Elizabeth
Jarvis have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal this
day & Year above written

I now live together with the house thereon, to my beloved wife Polly
Byrnes during her lifetime or widowhood and no longer & I do bequeath
my three orphaned Children and Nurse and School them on &c
I do give and bequeath to my son James Byrnes fifty acres of
land lying in Buckholms Island being the land that came by
my first wife Sarah to him & his heirs forever
I do give and bequeath to my son Samuel Byrnes the land that
I bought of Josiah Bell and George Whitehead & George
Holladay Land being Twenty one acres more or less as will appear
by the deeds thereto & to him & his heirs for ever I do after my wife
death or intermarriage give the maiden plantation below named
to the child that my wife Polly is now pregnant with in case it is a
boy, but if a girl I give the said land and plantation to my
son James to him and his heirs for ever and in case it so happens
that the child that my wife is now pregnant with should be a
