negro Woman called Chloe, one cow and yearling
which she has already received, four ewes, one large
dutch oven and all the things that I have before
lent her —

I give to my Daughter Francis Dwyer one
Negro Man called Jack. —

I give to my grand daughter Margaret Munroe
one cow and calf —

I give to my grand daughter Molly Manning
one feather bed and furniture, one large trunk
and one iron wheel —

I give to my grand daughter Elizabeth Cook
Valentine one large brass skillet —

I give to my grand daughter Elizabeth Dwyer
two ewes and lambs — I am —

I give to my grand daughter Nancy Baxter
one cow and calf —

I give to my Son James Foubie Twenty pounds
current money —

I give to my Son Thomas Cooper Foubie one Negro
boy called George one bay mare called Nancy, one yoke of
bees, one ox cart one ox chain one horse cart all my
Deeds Notes and Accounts, the Coop that is now getting
(all my pewter and cookery, only I wish him to let me
to let James Foubie have a part provided he will
will take care of it) and all the remainder of my
estate after making good my before mentioned
Gifts —

Lastly I nominate and appoint my sons Joseph
Foubie Esq: Foubie and Thomas Cooper Foubie
my whole and sole Executors to this my last
Will and Testament revoking and annulling
all others I or witnesses whereof I have heretofore
set my hand and affixed my seal this 25th
day of August Anno Domini 1794
