

The Last Will and Testament of Enoch J. Forbes
 of North Carolina Currituck County in the
 name of God Amen Enoch J. Forbes of the County and State
 aforesaid being weak and feeble body But in sound sense
 and memory do this day make and ordain this my last
 will and testament in manner and form as follows
 First I recommend my soul to God that gave it Secondly
 my body to the decision of my Executors to be buried in
 a christianlike manner and touching such worldly
 goods as it hath been pleased God to bless me with I
 dispose of in manner and form as follows Item first
 I desire that all my just debts to be paid Item 2^d Secondly
 I lend to my Loving wife Nancy Forbes after all my just
 debts is paid all of my personal estate now in my possession
 for the purpos of raising and schooling of my children
 upon during of her life or widowhood with the privilege
 of selling such articles of property as she may think
 perishable and after her death or marriage an equal
 division to take place of my personal Estate among
 all my children to viz John P. Forbes Polley Forbes
 Sally Forbes Samuel J. Forbes Wilson J. Forbes
 and it is my will and desire that at the manage of my
 son John J. Forbes that at the discretion of my wife
 if there is as much personal property as to make my
 children Equal one bed and furniture one table and
 one chest also to my Daughter Polley Forbes one Bed
 and Furniture one cow and calf one table and
 one trunk to my Daughter Sally Forbes one
 bed and furniture one cow and calf one table
 and one trunk to my son Samuel J. Forbes one
 bed and furniture one cow and calf one table
 and one trunk - To my son Widow J. Forbes
 one cow and calf one bed furniture one
 table and chest - Also I gave and bequeath

To my loving son Samuel J. Forbes the piece of
 land deeded to me from Adah Mann on the North
 west side of the plantation whereon I now live
 containing fifty acres to him and his heirs and
 assigns forever Item I gave and bequeath to
 loving son Wilson J. Forbes the piece of Land
 deeded to me from Daniel Baum and wife Polley
 Baum on the South East side of the plantation
 whereon I now live containing fifty acres to
 him and his heirs and assigns forever and I
 hereby ordain my loving wife Nancy Forbes exec-
 tor to this my last will and testament in witness
 whereof the said Enoch J. Forbes have here unto set
 my hand and seal to this my last will
 and testament this seventh day of August in
 the year one thousand eight hundred and
 twenty three Signed Sealed and published
 and declared by the said testator as his last
 will and testament in presence of
