at the discretion of my executors, nothing doubting but at the General
Resurrection, I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of
God. And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased
God to bless me in this life, I Give and dispose of the same in
the following manner and form, first I Give & bequeath to my
Beloved friends, Hephiah Farrow that is to say one feather bed and
Furniture & five bushels of corn, and all the rest of my Estate
That belongs to me, agreeable to my husband Thomas Austin's last will
and Testament to him and his heirs forever. I likewise
Make and appoint Ordain my friend Thomas Farrow and
Hephiah Farrow my whole and sole executors, to this my last
Will and Testament & to settle my estate according to this my
last will and Testament & as the Law shall direct in writing
that I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this 1st day of
September, One thousand eight hundred and five.
