to her & her heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my daughter Francis Edrings one bed of  
furniture to her & her heirs forever

And the remaining part of my property to be equally divided between  
my Son Thomas Edrings Francis Edrings Nicholas Edrings &  
Fanny Edrings I make for same my worthy Son John Whittier
