Endue me with. I Give and Dispose as follows.
Item I Give and bequeath to my son Caleb Jones my Negro Watch
Tide and all my Silver Money that I Have by me at my death
and one Pine Chest and the whole of my Horses in my stable
and two young Steers, the said things to my son Caleb Jones
his heirs forever.
Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Jones my box chest
and half of my wearing clothes to her and her heirs forever.
Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Jones my Ham-
ing Barn and one large Potato Patch and the other half
of my wearing clothes to her and her heirs forever.
Item I Give and bequeath to my three Children now living
Hamley Caleb Maria Sarah Jones and Ann Jones all my things
and most and Come to be Equally Divided between
to them and their heirs forever.
Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Jones and
Archiball More the third part of all my Estate that I Have
not already Given to be Equally Divided between them, and
if my Daughter Sarah Jones dies without issue of her body
then I Give to Archiball More to him and his heirs forever.
Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann Jones and my son
John's Children, the other two Parts of the whole Estate that
I Have Not Given that is one half of the said two Parts
to my Daughter Ann Jones to her and her heirs forever
And the other Part to be Equally Divided between my said son
John's Children now living, Malachi Ruden & Caleb and

and Liddan Ann and Sally More to them and their heirs
forever.
Altho I Have Disposed of all my living yet I Desire that my Grand
Daughter Frances Cox should have my Silver Chest.
And Lastly I Constituted and appointed my son Caleb Jones
my sole and whole Executor of this my last Will and Testament
Resolving and Disavowing all other Wills & Testaments
formerly made by me and satisfying and Confirming this
and no other to be my last Will & Testament In Witness
Whereof I do Sign unto set my Hand & Seal this Fourth
Day of May one thousand seven hundred and seventy two

Impiously I bequeath to my loving Wife Ann Byrnes the use of this
Plantation now living, and the use of another Plantation called
Teaching with both the Orchards during Widowhood to raise and
support my four youngest Children with.
Item I Give unto my Wife Ann one Cow and Calf, & one small
my Stock of Cattle Sheep and other with all the Rest of my Personal
Estate within door and without during Widowhood (Eight shillings &
pence excepted which will be given hereafter to my Children)
and after that Decree to be kept together for the Maintenance
of my three youngest Daughters Ann Lydia & Elizabeth
(that is to say) after the Widowhood of Elizabeth and Lydia Ann
to have the whole use of the 2^d of the 2^d of Cattle Sheep & other
long as she shall live single, and after Marriage to be Equally
Divided amongst my four Daughters together with what
