Lastly I do hereby appoint Jacob Ball the whole and sole Executor to this my last will & testament whereunto I have here unto set my hand and affixed this 26 day of May 1832

In the name of God amen I Benjamin B. Hallam of the County of Connecticut and State of New Hampshire being sick of body but of sound mind and memory do make and Ordain this my last will and testament in form following

Item I give and bequeath unto my son James B. Hallam one bed and furniture and bed cloth one wheel my saddle the half of my young mare one road huffer two years old last spring and all my land west of the trap fence running from near Simmons oval house westerly near Nathan Payner's house also all the woodling land that is easterly of said fence inside of my plantation.

Item I give and bequeath to my wife Nancy Hallam all of my parishable estate that I have now all ready given away unto her and her lawful heirs for ever I also find my such Nancy Hallam all the cleared land from said trap fence before mentioned easterly with in my boundaries to gather with all the houses during her natural life and then I give after her death I give unto my son James B. Hallam the said land which have first to my wife after my lawful debts are paid together all the rest of my land I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife Nancy and John Jarvis S. S. Executors to this my Last will and testament revoking all former wills here unto made Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 3rd day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty three
