last will and Testament.

Simmings one bed and furniture, to Polly Simmings one cow and
calf name Flower, and one chest not painted to them and their

by name Jefail, and in payment to the amount of two
hundred dollars, which is now in the Sheriff's hands against
Willis Simmings, likewise, after paying H. Goughly Poier
one hundred and sixty seven dollars that he last did, I

their heirs forever. Also, I give to John W. Simmings one
table sparsen under No time and his heirs forever, also I give
Mary Dozier one cow and calf choice to her and her

and sole Executrix to this my last will and Testament, this
my last will and Testament made April the fourteenth one
thousand eight hundred and fifteen. I acknowledge this to
