there on To him & his heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son John Jamison all my plantation
known by the name of Meigs Point in Amiteuch County in North
Carolina with all the marsh Land thereon belonging with all
my Smiths Tools to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give to my son John Jamison & my Daughter Molly Wilson all
my stock of Horses Cattle Sheep & Hogs with all my Household
& Kitchen furniture, with all my plantation Mills & also my
Negroes namely Owen, Pleasant, Short fern, Moggie, Boy, Cesar,
Simon, Great Hannah & Seloa as Tenant and Common, To them
and their heirs forever.

Item I give to my Daughter Molly Wilson one lot of ground in the County
of Norfolk, which I purchased of John Williamson To her & her heirs
forever.

Item, I give & bequeath to my Daughter Margaret Waynes, one Negroe
woman named Cate & one Negroe man named Jack Hunter To her &
her heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Weston, one Negroe man
named Sam Beay, one Negroe woman named Senter, one Negroe girl
named Serenethen, one ditty named Fanny To her & her heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Grandson George Waynes, my Negroe Boy Harry
that went away with the British To him & his heirs forever.

Item, I give & bequeath To my grand Daughter Peggy Waynes one my
girl known by the name of Amy To her & her heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my grand Daughter, George Jamison, one
Negroe girl named Fanny Daughter To her & her heirs forever.

Item, I give & bequeath unto my grand son Thomas Waynes, my negroe
girl named Sue To him and his heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Grand son Thomas Waynes, one
Negroe Daughter of Cate To him & his heirs forever.

Item, I give & bequeath unto my Grandson Erasmus Waynes one
Negroe girl named Nancy To him & his heirs forever.

Item, I give & bequeath unto my Grandson George Jamison, one
Negroe girl named Jenny To him & his heirs forever.

Item, I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter, Betty Weston, one
Negroe girl named Phillander To her & her heirs forever.

Item, I give & bequeath To my Grandson George Weston, one negroe
boy named Ralph To him & his heirs forever.

Item, I give & bequeath To my Grandson Richard Weston, one negroe
girl named Rose To him & his heirs forever.

And I will that all my Just debts either by bond bill or judgment Or
open Accounts, To be Equally divided among my above named children.

I will that all my Just debts & funeral charges be paid out of the m-
eys arising from the same, Of the above. And lastly I Constitute and
Appoint my worthy friend Hollowell Milnes of Amiteuch County North
Carolina, Elder Freeman my son John Jamison, & my Daughter Molly
Wilson Executors to this my last will & Testament & I do hereby disavow &
revoke, & disannull all former other Testament & Will Against & Against &
Executors by me in any ways made & bequeathed, hereafter this I do
make to be my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal this Twenty sixth day of May one thousand seven hundred &
eighty four.
