

Which said One hundred and fifty acres of Swamp belong
equally between James Holmes, Edward Daughtry & myself & is
yet undivided. Also One half of an Entry for Six hundred forty
acres of Swamp lying on the North West side of the said
Road & joining Jordan Lamb's Patent, & one half of two
other Entries lying on each side of the said Road between the
said Lamb's Patent & Camden County, to hold the said pieces and
parcels of Swamp with their appurtenances to the
said Lamb. Say his heirs & assigns forever. And my will
is that the division of the above mentioned Tracts or parcels
of Swamp shall be upon the division & at the dis-
cretion of my Executors. The other moiety or - half
of all the above described Tracts or parcels of the said Swamp
I leave in trust to my Executors the trustee thereof to be worked
up at their discretion and the monies arising therefrom to be
put to Interest and also the monies arising from the sale of
my personal Estate as above mentioned. The whole to be equally
divided between my Grandchildren above named in manner
herein after directed (that is to say) when either of them shall
come or be of lawful age, then I will & desire that my Executors
shall pay them or either of them their equal Quota of the
said Monies & the Interest thereon. And if either of my said
Grandchildren shall die before they come of lawful age then
my will is that their quota of the said Monies shall be
equally divided between all the survivors. Further my will
is that when either of my said Grandchildren shall come of
lawful age I shall require the same that my Executors shall
cause their equal portion (as nearly as may be according to
quality) of the said Swamp to be laid off to them or either of
them, which shall be in full for their part thereof. And lastly
I hereby Appoint my Son-in-Law, Daniel Badgley & Benjamin
Jones Executors to this my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all
former Wills by me made. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 25th day of September Anno Dom. Seventeen
hundred & Eighty four.

In the name of God Amen. The Twenty third day of June, 1784
year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & eighty four I Isaac
Tarraco last of Brunswick County in the State of North Carolina being
very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be
given to God I have called unto mind the Modesty of my body, and
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & declare
this my last Will & Testament. That is to say, I hereby & last of all I
recommend my soul unto the hands of God that give it, and for my body
I recommend it to the Earth, to be buried in a Christian like & usual manner
at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general re-
urrection I shall receive the same again in the mighty power of God.
And as touching such worldly Estate, whosoever it hath pleased God to
bestow on me in this life, I give devise & dispose of the same in the following
manner. I leave & bequeath, I give & devise that is the first place
all my just debts and funeral charges to be paid & satisfied. Item I leave
bequeath to my dearly beloved Wife, Emily Tarraco, this House wherein
I live during her natural life, also two feather Beds & such household
furniture as may be sufficient for her use. Five Cows & calves, four
Cows One being three or more as she thinks proper to take, that I give &
bequeath to my Daughters, Mary Brooks, Rosamon Pickens, Phoebe Ann
Sarah Hancock, Barbara Phillips the sum of One Million one hundred
thousand of North Carolina cash, to my Daughter, Cornelia Williams
two Cows & calves, Next to my youngest Son, James Tarraco
I leave this Plantation in manner & form as follows. Beginning at
Grand Lac Runnings a due East Course to the Sea also joining Mary
Matis Lane along the Sea side Southward to Ashes Creek that begins
to the Sound then various Courses to the last Station also the
area of land being part of the North end of a due of my brother
Isaac Tarraco with all the properties & appurtenances belonging
Next I leave to my Eldest Son Isaac Tarraco the remainder part of
all my lands & plantations also the just half of all my moveables &
cattle, sheep, horses hogs, & household furniture. The remainder
half of said to Francis Tarraco. Likewise to Isaac Tarraco one
Negro Wench named Susu. Then I increase that may hereafter be
born, her child named William that is already born to my Son
James Tarraco, they said Isaac & Francis Tarraco paying me
said Legacies to their Sisters as above mentioned & they said Isaac &
& Francis Tarraco whom I likewise constitute make & name my sole
Executors of this my last Will & Testament. And I do hereby revoke
revoke & disannul all former wills Legacies & Executors be-
fore in any ways before this time mentioned or named Will &
bequeath this testifying & confirming this to be my last
Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand the day & year above written.
