last Will & Testament is that I bequeath my whole Estate
God who gave it and my body to be buried in a decent
manner at the discretion of my Executors herein after
named that is to say first I bequeath to my son
Thomas Morcor one Shilling together with what he has
already rec^d to him and his heirs for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Sally Bostons children
one Shilling to them & their heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Ruth Harvey one
Shilling to her & her heirs for ever

Item I bequeath to my son Jeremiah Morcor all my
Land which I have hitherto given him to him and his
heirs for ever one hand Mill & also in hand Mill in the
hands of Elizabeth Sturges to him and his heirs for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my beloved Wife Winiford Morcor
one Cow & calf and one feather bed & furniture one Negro
man named Jack during her Natural life and after her
Death to my daughter Elizabeth Jarvis to her & her heirs
for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my son Jeremiah Morcor one young
horse called Roger to him & his heirs for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Winiford Bostons one
Note of hand due from Thomas Harris for one young
horse for twenty one pounds ten Shillings or the horse
& returned to her and her heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally Whittham
one Shilling together with what she has already received
to her and her heirs for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Jarvis all
the rest of my Estate which I have not already given
away (except one Cow & calf which I have given
to my beloved Daughter Winiford Jarvis) to her
and her heirs for ever - after my last debt paid
to my Executors

and my will desire is that my May Mark Traveller the
stay on the Plantation for the use of my Wife during
her Natural life

Then I make constitute and appoint my son Jeremiah
Morcor and my friends Joseph Ferbera John Ferbera
whole and sole Executors of this my last Will &
Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 20th day
of September in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred & Ninety six

In the Name of God Amen I Henry Good being freely in
body but of sound and disposing memory thanks be to God for it and
do make this my last Will in Maner as follows to wit
Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Virnich Good all my Estate
which I have now or which is coming out of the Estate of Mary
Campbell de^d except as much of my Estate as will maintain my
son Henry Good till he gets big enough to be bound out to her
and her heirs but if my daughter Virnich Good should die before
she has any heirs of her body I give all my Wife's Est to my
Daughter Sarah Good and her heirs and all the rest of my daughter
Virnich's Estate to my son Henry Good in the care of my friends John
Simmons as his sole Est to be de^d with at his discretion till he
comes to lawful age not compelling him to give him anything
but to be raised in a Christian like manner and I do give it in the
presence of my Executors here after appointed to all my Estate
and in any Manner as he thinks best for the support of my
two Children before mentioned and I do constitute and appoint
my friends John Simmons my sole and sole Executors of this my
last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 2^d day of June 1793
