 Form followeth

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Patience Hodges
 One Shilling Sterling money and what I have already
 Give her to her and her heirs forever for her part of my
 Estate

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Grandson Richard Smith
 One Shilling Sterling money and what I have Give him
 to him & his heirs forever for his Part of my Estate

Item I Give and bequeath to my Grandson Henry Smith One
 Shilling Sterling money and what I have Give him to
 him & his heirs forever for his Part of my Estate

Item I Give & bequeath One Gun to William Matthias
 to him and his heirs forever for his Part of my Estate

Further I Give and bequeath to my Loving Wife all my Estate
 Real and Personal within Doors and with Out to her
 and her heirs forever Signed Sealed Published Pronounced
 and Testament in his Presence and in the Presence of Each
 Other Name hereto Subscribed Our Names

 that I Lazarus Linton of the County of Currituck and State of N.
 Carolina am Sick and Weak of Body but of Sound Memory
 Thank God for that as it is so ordered that all men must
 see I Make and Publish this my Last Will and Testament
 all that I have Given away in Deeds of Gifts
 Item I Give to my Wife One Yoke of Oxen the Road that her
 Father Gave me thirty Dollars in Money two Cows and Calves
 three Cows and Lambs and I send the use of my Patience
 and Little Tract for the Term of One Year untill they shall
 arrive to the Years of Twenty one Also I bind my Two
 youngest Negroes as apprentices untill they shall arrive to the
 Years of Twenty one and then to be Discharged Rose and Silve
 all the Remainder part of my Personal Property to be sold at
 Publick Vendue for Twelve Months the Good and the Money to
 be Equally Divided Between my Wife and My sisters five
 Children
