I Nathl Walker being sick and weak in body but of perfect Memory and using to mind the mortality of the body knowing it is so nec ordained for all men to die doe hereby constitute and ordain that my last Will and Testament in the Manner and form following that is to say first of all I commend my soul into the hands of almighty God who first gave it me Secondly I desire that all my Just Debts should be paid by my Executors hereafter named and my body to be decently interred in the earth Thirdly I desire and doe hereby give an bequeth unto my beloved Son Asa Walker all that piece of land I bought of Nathl's Father lying on the North Banks. Fourthly I lend to my beloved Wife Sarah Walker all my Personal Property during her Widowhood or as long as she and her Children shall be fit to keep House and if she breaks up or Marries before her Death then I desire it shall be equally divided amongst all my Children that shall survive her and I doe hereby constitute and ordain my son Asa Walker my hea and sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament in Witness to the same I have hereunto set my hand and put my seal this 15th day of January 1798

In the Name of God Amen I Jesse Gregory of the County of Currituck and State of North Carolina Planter being of sound and perfect mind and Memory bless be God for it do this sixteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Eight Make and publish this my last Will and Testament in Manner following that is to say

Item I give and bequeth to my son Isaac Gregory one half of that tract of Land in Camden County laying in the State which he hath already got a Deed for to him and his assigns

Item I give and bequeth to my son Calub Gregory the other half of the said tract of Land laying in Camden County for which he has got a Deed to him and his heirs forever

Item I have the yoke of all the Land and Plantation whereon I now live together with all my stock of every kind and all my household Goods and Plantation tools of every kind to my beloved Wife Mary Gregory for and during her Natural life

Item I give to my daughter Peggy Moss five Shillings together with what she has already received to her and her heirs &c

Item I give to my son Thomas Gregory one half of my home Plantation after the Death of his Mother it being the South end of said plantation beginning at Richard's Station line fence running across the plantation along a ditch to North River swamp and then a straight course to the river to him and his heirs forever

Item I give to my Samuel Gregory all the remainder of my Plantation after the Death of his Mother to him and his heirs forever and if either of my two sons Thomas Gregory or Samuel Gregory should die without a lawful Issue lawfully begotten then his part of the Land and all to his surviving Brother. And my Will and desire is that after the death of my Wife Mary that all my Estate shall be equally divided between my five Children that is to say Thomas Gregory Lucy Gregory Eliza Gregory Ann Gregory & Samuel Gregory &c In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and put my seal the day and year written and I doe constitute and appoint my Son Thomas Gregory and my friend Joseph Cooke my Executors to this my last Will and Testament &c
