 Province of North Carolina being weak of Body but
 sound in Mind and perfect in my Senses be to God for it and
 now calling to mind the uncertainty of this Life &
 knowing that I am appointed for it Men once to die
 and after I shall be judged by God I give and bequeath
 my Soul to God with good and easy Body to the Dust
 from whence it came to be Revived at the Pleasure of
 my Creator hereafter appointed a widow for my Wife
 Elizabeth Litchfield of both Parties pleased God to bless me with 1st Son
 and be his as follows.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Cousin Peter Litchfield
 one half of my Land and how to him and his heirs forever.
 Item I give and bequeath to my Cousin Robert Litchfield Jun^r the other
 half of my Land and how to be Equally Divided Between the
 my Cousin the Land and how to him and his heirs forever.
 And if either of these shall Die without heirs my Will

Further is that it should go to my Cousin William Hen-
 son and John Henson to him forever.

Item I give to my Dear Friends Abraham Litchfield & El-
 eah Litchfield John Henson & David Gibson what moveable
 Estate I have to be Equally Divided Between them
 I have also given my Cousin Brother Peter Litchfield
 one half of this my Last Will and Testament Published
 & pronounced by me the said Jacob Litchfield to be my
 Last Will and Testament this 3rd Day of December 1774
