 her Natural Life my House and Twenty five Acres of Land
 And after her Death to my Well and beloved Son Bartholomew Dudley
 I also Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth Dudley
 During her Widowhood my Negro Wench Rose my horse my
 Household furniture Except Two beds Likewise my Breanger
 Two Cows & Calves to my Wife and After her Widowhood I
 Leave my household furniture my two Cows and Calves to
 My two Daughters Margaret Dudley and Sally Dudley
 I Give and bequeath to my two beloved Sons John Dudley
 And Demsey Dudley my Pilot Boat and Materials ~~and~~
 One Cow and calf and one Bed a piece and after my beloved
 Wife ~~Widowhood~~ I Leave my Negro Wench Rose and my horse
 to the mutual help of my Children I also Give and bequeath
 to my two beloved Sons Joseph Dudley and Natty Dudley
 fifty Acres of Land Lying and being on the Green Islands &
 One heffer a piece I Leave my Sheep to be Equally Divided
 Amongst four of my Children That is Joseph Dudley
 Natty Dudley Margaret Dudley and Sally Dudley
 I also have fifty Acres of Land Lying and being on the
 South west Side of Kings Point joining the Indian
 Line to be sold and Equally Divided Amongst all my

Children I Likewise ~~likewise~~ make and ordain
 Demsey Dudley and my Wife Elizabeth Dudley Executors
 of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utter
 = by Disallow revoke and Disannul all and Every other former
 Testament Wills Legacies bequests and Executors by me in
 Any Way before Named Will'd and bequeathed Made
 And Confirming this and no other to be my last Will and
 Testament In witness Whereof I have here unto set
 My hand and seal this And Eleventh Day of June in
 the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred
 And Ninety Eight
