Dispose of the same in the following Manner & form —

Item I give & bequeath to my son Thomas Lufmon my plantation
& all my Land and if my son Thomas Lufmon doth die
without Lawful heirs my will & devise is for Elizabeth
Cannaine to have my Plantation & Land to her forever
Item I give the Use of my Plantation to my Wife Elizabeth
Lufmon to her during of her life & likewise I devise for
my Wife to give my son Thomas Lufmon one year
of schooling and my is for my Executors is to sell
at publick sale all the rest of my Estate both within
Doors & without — I do ordain & appoint my dear
beloved Wife Elizabeth Lufmon my sole & sole Executor
to this my last Will & Testament Given under my
hand & Seal in this present year of our Lord one
Thousand seven hundred & Ninety five

of this my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof

of December in the Year of our Lord one Thousand
Seven hundred and Ninety five
