

In the Name of God Amen, James Ryan Esq of the County of Currituck & State of North Carolina, being sick of Body but of sound disposing mind & memory, bless'd be to Almighty God in Heav'n, do make & Ordain this last Will & Testament, First that I do hereby Recommend my soul to Almighty God that gave it me & my body to the divinely beav'd in abisace where it should, please my Executors hereafter nam'd here as to what Estate it hath been pleas'd God to bestow me, Myne and dispose in manner & form as followeth

First my last desire is that my loving wife Sabell Ryan should have the use of the old plantation whereon I now live, & all the land belonging to it during her life & after my de. I give the sd. land & plantation that her son Andrew Duke, when this heirs forever - Also my Will & desire is that the dividing line between me and Robert Devere should stand as we have made the

Item I give & bequeath unto the sd. Andrew Duke a Tract or parcel of land containing seventy five Acres more or less bounded as followeth, Beginning at William Monroes corner & running a South Side West Course to the back line of my patent & the said land being on the South East end of my patent & back of the said Andrew Dukes own land, to him & his heirs forever

I also give one Cow & calf to Frances Permines Daughter of Mary Gibson, to her & her heirs forever

I also Give all the Remainder of my Estate after all my Just debts & costs of debts of said Estate is well & truly paid, unto my loving wife Sabell Ryan, with her personal mother goods & without to her & her heirs forever

I also constitute & appoint my loving wife Sabell Ryan & Willis Churchgo my heirs & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament, to dispose my Estate settled According to this my last Will and the Law should require, as witness my hand & seal this Twelfth Day July Anno Dom. 1784

State of North Carolina Currituck County } In the name of God Amen, In the year of our Lord 1784 August 10 day, I Thomas Sanderson son of the County & State aforesaid being very sick & weak of body but of perfect mind & memory, thank be to God for the same, I have in calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & Ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following principally & first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of the King of Heav'n God that first gave it me & touching my worldly Goods & Estate whereunto it hath pleas'd God to bless me with, I do give & bequeath in manner & form following

I give & bequeath to my loving wife Anne Sanderson the use of the plantation whereon I now live during her natural life as it is set off, & after the decease of my said wife Anne, then to her son John Sanderson to him & his heirs forever, and in case my said son John Sanderson should die before his Mother or without Lawfull heirs of his body then to equally divided between my two Daughters Ann Sanderson & Lydia Sanderson to them & their heirs forever

I also give & bequeath to said wife during her natural life the use of all that part of Great Quarter Island that I bought of my son Thomas Sanderson as is mentioned in a Bond for the conveyance of the same and also as may appear by deed for the said land Great Quarter Island and after the natural life of my said wife then to my son John Sanderson & his heirs forever, and in case my said son John Sanderson should die before his Mother or without Lawfull heirs of his body then in that case to go to my 2 Daughters Ann Sanderson & Lydia Sanderson, and in case that either of my two Daughters Ann Sanderson & Lydia Sanderson should die without Lawfull heirs of their body then to go to the surviving sister or the Lawfull heir of her body

I also give & bequeath unto my said wife during her natural life the use of one Negro Woman called Fanous, also one Negro Fellow called Jupiter, also one Negro woman called Grace, also one Negro Fellow called Quash the use of each of the above Negroes during her natural life & after her decease, three of which aforesaid Negroes namely Jupiter, Quash & Grace to go to my son John Sanderson & his heirs, & after the decease of my said son then in that case the other within mentioned Negroes to go to my Daughter Julia Sanderson & her heirs, also I give to my son John Sanderson the use of three feather beds & furniture during her natural life

Item I give unto my son John Sanderson one Feather Bed & furniture
