I also left my wife, during her natural life, my negro man Buff, my negro girl Hamner, two feather beds and furniture his first choice, also her choice of my house hired, ten head of my hogs first choice, two cows and calves, eight head of sheep, each her first choice all my best lot furniture, and half my house hold and kitchen furniture, my riding chair and harness, and my cart, my loom and harness, and my spinning wheel, all these items lets she is to have the use of her, life time. Item. I give and bequeath to my son Joshua Harrison all that part of my land and plantation, which lays on the south side of the bank which runs through my plantation, to him and his heirs forever. I give and bequeath to my son Alfred Harrison that part of my land and plantation wherein my houses and orchards stands, on the N West side of the lane, as far as a pine tree stand at the S West corner of the land of John Hall esq; and from thence a straight course to a marked gun tree, standing at the head of a gushick pond, to him & his heirs forever. Item. I give and bequeath to my son William S. Harrison all the remainder of my tract of lands which lays to the north west of the division line mentioned above, between him and my son Alfred to him and his heirs forever. Item. I give and bequeath to my three sons Joshua, Alfred and William S. Harrison, all my lands on the north Banks as an equal right and privilege. I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Harrison my negro girl Nelly, with all her increase, and one feather bed and furniture. I give and bequeath to my two daughters Holland and Lurinda Harrison, at the death of my wife, my negro girl Hamner, and all her increase, to be equally divided among them, and if either of them die without lawful heir, I give her part to the other. I give and bequeath to my three sons Joshua, Alfred and William S. Harrison my negro man Isaac, and if either die without lawful heir, I give negro Isaac the son or sons that is living. I leave my vessel and all my stock on the north Banks, my stock on Newquater Island, and all my stock on Puffy point, and all the remainder of my personal estate, that I have not already given away to be sold on twelve monthly credit, excepting two feather beds and furniture, which I give one of said beds to my son Joshua and the other to William S. Harrison. I leave the money arising from the sale of my personal estate to be applied first to paying my just debts, all the remainder of the money after my debts are paid, I give to be equally divided among my three youngest children Lurinda, William S. and Alfred Harrison, all the personal property that I have left my wife, I leave to be sold at her death and the money to be equally divided among all my children.

Give and bequeath to my daughter Polly all my right and claim to the estate of Nancy Salden, which I bought of Thomas Salden if either of my three sons should die without lawful heir, I give their land to the son or sons that are living. Lastly of all I nominate, constitute and fully appoint my friend Thomas Joiner Esq; and my beloved wife, my whole and sole executors to this my last Will and Testament, as witness my hand and seal this 20th May 1810

that I James Thomas of the State and county aforesaid, do make and establish this instrument of writing to be my last will and Testament in manner and form to wit. And first I order all my just debts to be paid out of my estate, and as touching such worldly estate as it hath been please God to bless me with I bestow in the following manner, to wit. And first I give to my son James Thomas one bed and furniture, called the High bed, to him and his forever. Item. I then give to my wife Jane one bed and furniture forever. Item. Also give to said wife Jane one linen wheel *on her*. Item. I then give to my daughter Lydia chest alld the new chest, and one

linen wheel forever. Item. I then give to daughter Patsy, one small desk forever. Item. I then give to my son Joseph Thomas, one large sounding table forever. Item. I then give to son Adam, ten dollars to be raised out of my estate, to him for ever. Item. I then give to my three youngest sons John, Sam and William Hods, one shilling apiece and no more. Item. I then lend to my wife Jane the use of my house and plantation, during her widowhood, and at her death or marriage I then give to my only son James all my land and plantation, to him and his heirs forever, and I also constitute and appoint my trusty friend Thomas Brown to be my whole and sole executor to this my last will and Testament, revoking all others from the date hereof. Item. I then constitute and appoint my trusty friend Thomas Brown my whole and sole executor to this my last will and Testament, revoking all others. 
