 Decedent was exhibited in open Court and
 proved by the oath of Denis Gallant a subscribing
 Evidence thereto and ordered recorded
 When the Executors thereto came into open
 Court and ~~showed~~ in due form of Law

This last will & Testament of James White heretofore
 was was exhibited & proved at February Term 1821
 In the name of God amen I James White of the
 County of Crutwick being of sound and disposing
 mind & memory and calling to mind the uncertainty
 of human life and that it ever appointed for
 man to die do make and ordain this my last
 will & Testament in form following
 I Impair I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
 Ann White one Summative below Callaway to her and her
 heirs forever I also lend the land and plantation
 whereon I now live and all my moveable property
 during life and one negro boy named Luke
 and after his death the negro boy Luke appt.
 I Give to my two daughters Aseneth White and
 and Mariam Jarvis and their heirs forever
 Item I Give & bequeath to my son William White
 land & other property which he has already rec^d to him
 & his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy
 Balancerland and other property which she
 Item I Give and bequeath unto my daughter Margaret
 Jones Land & one mare and other property she
 has already Rec^d to her & her heirs forever
 Item I Give & bequeath unto my son James White the land
 I Bought of Holloway Gates on Baldy Island begin-
 -ing at the Gates line at a Chumk pine post on the land
 side thence Northw^{ly} with the water to a Chumk pine
 Post on land side about mid way of the land
 I Bought of John Bell thence wndly per op^t the
 plantation to the road to a Chumk pine post then
 through the road by a line of marked trees
 to the marsh including all the land down
 on the South side of the aforesaid line with a
 privilege in the marsh containing about a ~~one~~
 more or less to him & his heirs forever
 Item I Give and bequeath unto my son John and
 White all the remainder of my land I Bought
 of John Bell beginning at James White line at
 a Chumk pine post on the land side thence
 Northw^{ly} to Davis Jones line thence wndly
 with James line to the road thence through
 the road by a line of marked trees to the marsh
 including all the land down on the North
 side of James White line with a privilege
 in the marsh containing fifty acres more or
 less to him and his heirs forever
 Item I Give and bequeath to my son Henry
 White after the death of my wife Ann White
 part of the land I own on Chumky Island
 beginning on a cedar post on the East side
 of Island thence across the plantation a line
 Westwards to a pine at the marsh thence
 the same course through the marsh to the
 water side thence Northw^{ly} with the water
 variously curvy all round the north end of the
 Island to the first station to contain one
 Hundred & fifty acres be the same more or
 less with a privilege in wolf Harter marsh acc^g
 one half of the land & marsh I Bought of
 Joseph Grayson lying Island with other prop^{ty}
 by he has already Rec^d to him & his heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my daughter
 Mariah Harvey the remainder part of my land
 and plantation on Churchy Island after the
 death of my wife Anne White beginning at the
 aforesaid Cedar post Thomas White line thence
 northerly with the source to Thomas G. G.
 line thence south west with Gray line
 to the marsh thence with a ditch to the water
 thence northerly with water to Thomas White
 line thence easterly with said line to the first
 Station to Courtland G. G. agrees be the same
 more or less also the other half of my land
 and marsh on Jimmy Island I bought of
 Joseph Gray with other property she has
 already up to me she has forever
 I then I give and bequeath unto my daughter
 Aseneth White all my land and swamps
 in the Back woods of my Deeds including
 with other property she has already up to
 to me she has forever

I then I hereby empower my Executor to sell of
 my Black if it should increase to more than
 sufficient for the value to divide the
 money or note with my wife and children
 aforesaid or their Heirs.

I then I give and bequeath unto to all my children
 of and all my Bank Land to sell or divide
 a majority of them shall think best all the
 moveable property after the death of my said
 wife Ann White to be equally divided amongst
 all my children as a majority of them shall agree
 Lastly I hereby constitute appoint and ordain my son
 James White my wife Ann White and Aseneth Ball
 Executor to this my Last will and Testament
 Given under my hand and seal this 19 day
 of May 1821.

The Last will and Testament of Edmund J. Ogden
 Dec. 1821 at 11 a.m. 1821

In the name of God Amen. I Edmund Ogden
 of the County of Cumberland and in the State of
 North Carolina being of sound mind and
 Memory and Calling to mind the uncertainty
 of the things of this transitory world do make and ordain
 this my Last will and Testament and as
 touching this worldly substance with it has pleased
 God to bless me with do give and dispose of the
 same in the following manner viz

I give and bequeath to my two daughters Nancy &
 Patsy my home plantation to be equally divided
 between them and their Heirs forever
 I also give to my daughter Martha two Negroes
 one by the name of Wilson the other Abel. I also
 give to my daughter Nancy two Negroes one by
 the name of Yellow and the other by the name of
 Galy to them and their Heirs forever.

I moreover I give and bequeath to my daughter
 Margaretta the Reading tract of Land so called one
 to Mr. man called Daniel to use and his Heirs forever
 I moreover I give and bequeath to my beloved wife two
 Negroes one by the name of Hannah the other by the
 name of Black Red &c

I moreover I give and bequeath to my wife and three
 daughters all the remaining part of my Estate
 which I have not already given away including a piece
 of Swamp Land lying off Swamp land containing
 twenty four more or less and all appurtenant my two
 friends Philip Dozier & W. B. Barn and my Executors and
 assigns to my three children in ratification of the
 same I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
 the 27 March 1821.
