 and sick in body but of sound Memory declare that my  
 last Will & Testament first I bequeath my soul to Almighty  
 God who gave it and my body to be buried in a decent  
 manner at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter  
 named that is to say first I give and bequeath to my son  
 Thomas Moore one Shilling together with what he has  
 already rec<sup>d</sup> to him and his heirs for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Betty Pastors Child one  
 Shilling to her & her heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Ruth Liberty one  
 Shilling to her & her heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my son Jeremiah Moore all my  
 Land which I have hitherto given him to him and his  
 heirs for ever one hand Mill & also one hand Mill in the  
 hands of Elizabeth Strange to him and his heirs for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my beloved Wife Winiford & those  
 one cow & calf and one feather bed & furniture one Myro  
 man named Jack during her Natural life and after her  
 Decease to my Daughter Elizabeth James to her & her heirs  
 for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my son Jeremiah Moore one young  
 horse called Roger to him & his heirs for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Winiford & others one  
 Note of hand due from Thomas Harris for one young  
 horse for twenty one pounds ten Shillings on the horse  
 & returned to her and her heirs for ever

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Betty Whittham  
 one Shilling together with what she has already rec<sup>d</sup> to  
 her and her heirs for ever

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth James all  
 the rest of my Estate which I have not already given  
 away (except one cow & calf which I have given  
 to my beloved Daughter Winiford James) to her  
 and her heirs for ever - after my last debt paid  
 & expens<sup>s</sup> of my last

and my will desire it that my May Mark Traveller the  
 Mayor the Plantation for the use of my Wife during  
 her Natural life

Item I make constitute and appoint my son Jeremiah  
 Moore and my friend Joseph Furber Executors of this my  
 whole and sole Executors of this my last Will &  
 Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and affixed my seal this 18th day  
 of September in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 seven hundred & Ninety six  
 Acknowledged in Presence of us to be his  
 last Will & Testament

In the Name of God Amen I Henry Greed being poorly in  
 body but of sound and disposing memory thanks be to God for it and  
 do make this my last Will in manner as follows to wit

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Viruch Greed all my Estate  
 which I have now or which is coming out of the Estate of Mary  
 Campbell deb<sup>t</sup> except as much of my Estate as will maintain my  
 son Henry Greed till he gets big enough to be bound out to her  
 and her heirs but if my daughter Viruch Greed should die before  
 she has any heirs of her body I give all my Wife Clo<sup>s</sup> to my  
 Daughter Sarah Greed and her heirs and all the rest of my daughter  
 Viruch Greed to my son Henry Greed in the care of my friend John  
 Simmons as his own Child to be do<sup>t</sup> with at his discretion till he  
 cometh to lawful age not compelling him to give him anything  
 but to be reared in a Christian like manner and do leave it on the  
 power of my Executors hereafter appointed to sell my Estate  
 (and in any manner as he thinketh best for the support of my  
 two Children before mentioned and I do constitute and appoint  
 my friend John Simmons my sole and only Executors of this my  
 last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and seal this 2<sup>d</sup> day of June 1793
