taken as my Last Will & Testament, first that I do say

and my body to be buried in a Christian like
manner & buried in a place where it should please
my Executors hereafter named and as to what
Worldly Estate it hath been please God to bestow me
far above my Deserts I give & dispose in manner
& form as followeth, first my Will & desire is that all
my just debts & funeral charges should be first paid
in convenient time after my decease —
My will & desire is that this hundred & fifty acres of
Land where I now live should be sold at publick
auction in Eighteen Months after my decease for
the support of my Family likewise my will &
desire that my loving wife Fanny should have the
use of all my Movable Estate during her life time
or Widowhood for the support of my Children and
after that to be Equally Divided amongst them
I also constitute and appoint my loving Wife
Fanny & my friend William Miller

my whole & sole Executors to this my last Will &
Testament to settle all my Business according to
this my last Will and Testament and the Law
shall require as Witness my hand & Seal this
20th day of February in the year of our Lord,
Anne D^y 1794 or
