 an perfect Memory & calling to mind the mortality of the Body I thought proper
 to make this my last Will & Testament touching all former Wills at all ever
 constituted & appointing this to be my last Will & Testament, As to my Lands
 and worldly Goods I thought proper to dispose of them in manner & forms follows
 Item I give unto my Son George Davis Chuslers for ever one hundred Acres of Land
 lying at the Head of my Land where he hath now settled & the remaining Part
 of my Land I give unto my Son Ephraim Davis Chuslers for ever
 Item I give unto my Son John Davis a negro Boy called Robin
 Item I give unto my Son Spaphrodus Davis a negro Girl called Inda
 She & her Increase to have & to hold the same he & his Heirs And my will is
 that my dear & well beloved Wife have the use & service of my Negro
 Woman called Demiana during her Widow hood & when that is ended the
 said negro Woman & her Increase to fall to my Son Ephraim Davis and
 her Heirs I give unto my Daughter Sarah Richards one Lane & Land
 and my will is that my dear and well beloved Wife have the use of all
 my Household Goods during her Widow hood & after ward to be divided
 amongst my three Sons Ephraim, John & Spaphrodus Davis & also
 my will is that after my just Debts are paid & the Administration exe-
 cuted this my Will that my Wife Anne keep the remaining Part of my Lock
 during her Widow hood And lastly by my Will is my Son Ephraim Davis
 be my whole & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 20 Day
 of September 1765
