I Give my Mother Bazel Becham all my stock of hogs on Sanguar Island and one head and furniture second choice of Sun Bazel one cow and calf 3 choices also one table first choice and one head mill.

I Give to my Sister Betsey Becham one heifer 2 years to 3 years on Sanguar Island about 3 years old at this time one chest and one lining wheel and one table 2 choices

I Give to my Sister Mary Becham 1 loom 1 profat and furniture and one wooden wheel and all the pot ware belonging to me now in possession of my Mother and set off them

I also Give to Love Hobbs and George Hobbs and Lemmy Hobbs three dollars among the 3 that is to say one dollar each to be paid to them by my Executor when he thinks proper.

I also Give the remainder of my property that is not mentioned before Equally to be divided between Thos Becham and Bazel Becham and Mary Becham and I hereby make and ordain my worthy friend and Brother Thos Becham Executor to this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have set my hand & affixed my seal day and date before written

In the name of God Amen I John Harrison Sen of the County and state aforesaid being awake in body but of sound mind and memory Calling to mind that it is once appointed for all men to die do make and publish this to be my last will and Testament in manner as follows.
First it is my will and desire that all of my Chattel property of every kind should be sold and the money equally divided between my wife Sally & son Abner & Elizabeth Latham after my debts be paid out of it.

2 Now as to my Land and plantations I have on I now live I Give to my wife Sally Harrison during of her life or widowhood and my wife should marry it is my

will that she should take her thirds out of the land as though I left no will.
Lastly I leave my wife Sally Harrison Executors to this my last will and Testament this 18th October 1832

And I further appoint my worthy friend Crook L Stephens my Executor to this my last will and Testament Revoking all other will or wills before this in any manner what ever in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 5th of March in the Year of our Lord 1832
