Publish this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say  
I send the use of my slaves land to my beloved wife Elizabeth Scars during  
her widowhood

I give and bequeath unto my wife Elizabeth two Cows and Calves bone  
Mare and foal black Marrow 2 year old & one black mare 2 year old  
I give further Birds and furniture to all my household furniture. sell my  
Cows & Pork & few Stocks of her and all my ploughing horses & Cows.  
I send the use of my Negro woman Rachael to my wife during her widow  
hood I give and bequeath to my son John Scars all the land I bought of  
Jacob Perkins to him and his heirs forever

I give bequeath to my Child that my wife has now No. 1 and all the rest of  
My land to that Child hers forever if it is live born & if not I give the  
Same Land to my son John Scars and his heirs forever

I have my Negro woman Rachael and her increase to be equally divided  
between my son John Scars & my other Child if live born when they come  
to the age of twenty one years to them other heirs forever  
I have all the rest of my property after paying of my debts to be equally  
Divided between my children when they are of age to be

And thereby make and ordain my friends Matthew Simmons,  
Executor of this my Last will & Testament in writing whereof I the

Said John Scars have to this my Last will and Testament

I Nathan Hall of the State of North Carolina and County of  
Currituck being sound in body but of sound disposing Mind and Memory thank be to  
Almighty God for the same and Calling to Mind uncertainty of this life do make an  
Omen this Instrument of Conveying My last Will and Testament first of all I recommend  
Soul to Almighty God that gave it Me and My body to be buried at the discretion of my  
Executors: and as for My worldly Estate that it has been given over to my Son John Scars  
Dispose of in Manner following first I give all My Justable Goods to be Paid pendente  
By My Executors and as for the remainder of My Estate I dispose of in Manner following  
Item I give and bequeath to Francis Williams fifty Silver dollars of the Bungs No  
Amount against My Estate and if the amounting any Amounts Only Twenty dollars to  
Nathan Hall his forever.

Item I give to my Son John Hall all my Estate that is Not Given away of every sort  
or kind whatever that is to say all my land on the Main and all my land on the  
Banks and all my Negro and Stock of all kinds and all my household furniture  
whatever to him and his heirs forever — and my will and desire is that if my Son  
John Hall and am before he comes to the age of Twenty One years that my Estate  
Shall go to him and in the following Manner First my will is that my brother  
Spence Hall shall have all my land that I do give to him and his heirs forever  
and my will is that William Estam shall have one Negroe boy by the Name of Gee  
Item my will is that my Cousin Nathan Grigory Two Negroes keep by the Names of  
Joshua and Dick to him and his heirs forever and my desire is that Elizabeth  
Walker shall have Ten pounds in Money or Support just as my Executor thinks best  
are the rest of my Estate that is Not already Given away I give and bequeath to my  
Brother Spence Hall that is to say all my Negro all my Stock and household furniture of  
all kinds whatever and all my wearing Apparel and every Part of my house  
furniture and his heirs forever and tenth hereby nominate and appoint my brother  
Spence Hall and my son John Hall my Executors to this my last Will and Testament and  
I do empower my Executor Spence Hall to sell any part of my Estate at publick or  
private Sale as he thinks proper to vesting to the above named persons all my Household  
this 25th day of March A.D. 1803.
