corn also three hogs barrows first choice after they set the first corn of
my crop the first choice of my Sows also three the first choice
of a second size of barrows also two Cows first choice to her to dispose of
at her option Item I Give ~~and bequeath~~ to my Son William
Lempson one bed bedstead and furniture thereto belonging to him and
his heirs forever Item I Give to my Son Zachariah Lempson
Two beds and their furniture one bedstead belong to one of the beds
the other without a bedstead also the plantation and land now
lying on the Indian lands which I purchased of Wm. Walker also
the one half of negro Africa which I bought of John Larson to be
divided between him and my daughter Abigail Lempson also one
Table also seven Rock Chairs Item I Give to my daughter
Abigail Lempson one bed and furniture one bedstead also my riding
Chair and its harness also the one half of the before mentioned negro
Africa also one Mountbatt. Item I Give to my before mentioned son
William Lempson twelve and a half acres of marsh land lying in
Lick hole Islands also one deer Item I Give seven slaves sold and
as much of my stock of cattle as will pay four negro Africa which I bought
of John Larson together with what notes I have on hand to be indented
In said payment Item I Give to before mentioned Son Zachariah Lempson
One good horse and my black horse to my daughter Abigail Lempson
also all my Sheep to be equally divided between Zachariah & Abigail my
Son and daughter and all the remaining of my stock of cattle to
be equally divided between the before mentioned Son and daughter Zachariah
and Abigail Lempson also all the remainder of my property that is not
given to be sold by my Executors and the monies arising therefrom
after my lawful debts as paid to be equally divided between my said
children Zachariah and Abigail Lempson caught one black beaver
Table I Give to my son Zachariah Lempson

68 I Give to my wife all my Cotton and flax and spun and
 and on also the home made cloth that is in the house and all the dung
 the cloth except my Gown to my son William and Gachariah Simpson
 I nominate and appoint my young Malachi Lewis my whole and sole
 Executor to this my last will and testament reaching all other former wills
 I witness whereof I have set my hand and seal my seal to be fixed
 the 21st day of October 1804

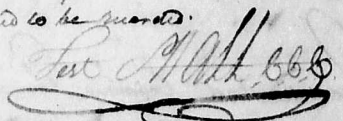

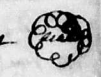
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On the Name of God amen I Will Williamson in the County of
 Currituck and State of North Carolina Being Very low in Health and
 of perfect mind and memory do ordain This to be my last will and
 testament and do dispose of my Property in the following Manner
 First I Give the land and plantation whereon I now live to my daughter Sarah
 Williamson and one third there and one third and one living child
 Reserving the use of the whole to my wife Lucy Williamson as long as she
 survives my widow

Secondly I Give one Negro Girl named Nance to my daughter Patsy
 Williamson Reserving the use of her to my wife as long as she lives and my
 widow and one fourth Nance to my daughter Patsy Reserving the use
 of it to my wife as long as she lives also one living child to my daughter
 Reserving the use of it to my wife during her natural life

Thirdly I Give to my beloved wife Lucy Williamson one Cow and
 Graveling also all my Corn and Peasch long low and Peigge two day
 Hay and I Give that my chimney should be put up on a piece of wood
 of my property that will be sold there all the Remainder part of my property
 to be sold one Equity divided between my wife and two children after paying
 my lawful debts I do hereby constitute and appoint John Rod and my wife
 Lucy Williamson Executors to this my last will and testament In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal in the year of our Lord one
