And the rest of my property to be sold, and for it to go for the raising of the small children, and schooling of my three youngest boys, Malachi and Thomas and Benjamin. And knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, in manner and form as follows. February 25th 1815. And first of all I give to my well beloved wife Hebe Stephens one feather bed and furniture and one chest and one linen wheel and three pound of hackled flax, and twenty yards of tow cloth chane and one sheep, also the use of my hand mill during her widowhood and then to be delivered to my son Tho. Stephens. I also give to my son Thomas Stephens one young horse called genius. I also give to my son Willoughby Stephens one young mare called diamond. I also give to my daughter Polly Stephens, one feather bed and furniture, and one linen wheel and three pounds of hackled flax, and one sheep and eighteen yards of tow cloth, and one small chest. And in case my wife and two children Polly and Thomas Stephens keep house together, I am willing they should have as much of my corn and pork and bacon as may

his presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names.

In the name of God, Amen. I Charles Lindsey of Crainock county and state of North Carolina, being weak and lame in body, but of perfect mind and memory, calling to mind the uncertainty of life & the certainty of death, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say, first of all I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the ground to be buried in a decent manner, at the discretion of my executor, and as for what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bless me with, I dispose of as follows, Viz. I leave unto my mother Susanna Simpson, my land and house whereon she now lives, during her natural life, and after her decease, I give and bequeath unto my sister Dinah Lindsey, all my land and houses that I possess, to her and her heirs forever. I give unto my sister Dinah Lindsey one cow called hard and her yearling, one chest, to her and her heirs. I leave I give and bequeath to my half brother James Simpson one cow and calf called poind, one bull, and all the property which I bought that was Alexander Simonsons, which was sold at Wardue. I give to the said James Simpson and his heirs forever. I leave I give and bequeath unto Daniel Shannon all the property that I hold which I bought at his wardue, which was sold for to pay off his debts, and his heirs forever. I also give and bequeath to Daniel Shannon the sum of twelve dollars out of the money that is due me at my death. I leave I leave unto James Simpson one feather bed and furniture during his life, and after his decease, I give the same bed and furniture to my sister Dinah Lindsey. I give to Alexander Simpson my gun called a musket and one steel trap. After my just debts are paid, I give to my mother the sum of thirty five dollars out of the money that is due me at my death; and all the remainder of my estate both personal and real, I give and bequeath to my sister Dinah Lindsey and her heirs forever. Lastly I nominate, constitute and appoint my friend Simcan Saeger my whole and sole executor, to this my last will and Testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine. Signed, sealed, pronounced
