boards for her own benefit excepting which I desire no
more timber to be cutt, down.

I do and lastly I appoint my dear brother William Wheatly
sole Executor of this my last will and Testament and in
Witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal this twenty
first day of February 1801.

Heir I give my said land and Plantation to my Cousin Richard Morse
and his heirs forever

I then I give all the rest of my Estate to be equally divided between
my sister Sarah Morse and sister Elizabeth Matthias and my brother
John Bray to them and their heirs forever

I do appoint Zachariah Morse and Simon Matthias Executors
of this my last will and Testament In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the 5th day
of December 1802.
